“THE HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE, No. 1 of 1928.”

WHEREAS by section 4 of the Holidays Ordinance, No. 1 of 1928, the full moon day of the Sinhalese month of Wesak and the day following are declared to be public holidays :

And whereas the full moon day of the said month in the year 1931 falls upon Saturday, the 2nd May :

And whereas by section 6 of the said Ordinance, Monday, the 4th May, 1931, is declared to be a public holiday instead of Sunday, the 3rd May, being the day following the full moon day in the Sinhalese month of Wesak aforesaid :

Now, therefore, it is hereby notified for general information that, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the said Ordinance, the Governor has been pleased to order that Friday, the 1st May, 1931, shall be a public holiday instead of Monday, the 4th May, 1931.

“THE HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE, No. 1 of 1928.”

WHEREAS by section 2 of the Holidays Ordinance, No. 1 of 1928, the full moon day of the Sinhalese month of Wesak is declared to be a bank holiday :

And whereas the full moon day of the said month in the year 1931 falls upon Saturday, the 2nd May :

It is hereby notified for general information that in exercise of the powers in him vested by section 7 of the said Ordinance, the Governor has been pleased to appoint Friday, the 1st May, 1931, to be a bank holiday in substitution for Saturday, the 2nd May, 1931.
