**GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.**

**THE CEYLON (STATE COUNCIL ELECTIONS) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1931.**

*(Article 32.)*

**Notification.**

*General Election of Members of the State Council in pursuance of a Proclamation by the Governor dated the Eighteenth day of April, 1931.*

**I**N pursuance of Article 32 of The Ceylon (State Council Elections) Order in Council, 1931, it is hereby notified by the Governor as follows:—

- (1) In the Electoral Districts specified in the first column of the schedule hereto the election of a Member of the State Council is contested.
- (2) In each of the said Electoral Districts a poll will be taken between eight o'clock in the forenoon and five o'clock in the afternoon on the date specified in the second column of the said schedule opposite to the name of that District in the first column.
- (3) The names of candidates nominated for election in each of the said Electoral Districts are given in the third column of the said schedule opposite to the name of that District in the first column, together with the colour allotted to each candidate by which the ballot box for the reception of ballot papers in favour of that candidate shall be distinguished at the poll and the names of the proposer and seconder of each candidate.
- (4) The situation of polling stations in each of the said Electoral Districts is specified in the fourth column of the said schedule opposite to the name of that District in the first column.
- (5) The sex, and areas of residence or the numbers of voters on the register of voters allotted to each polling station are specified in the fifth column of the said schedule opposite to the situation of the respective polling station specified in the fourth column.
