ORDINANCE. DRAFT

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:

An Ordinance to amend the School Teachers' Pension Ordinance, No. 6 of 1927.

E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

This Ordinance may be cited as The School Teachers' Pension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931.

Amendment of section 1 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section I of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "first day of August 1927" for the words "on a day to be fixed by the Governor by Procla-mation in the Government Gazette".

Construction of the principal Ordinance.

- 3 The principal Ordinance shall be generally construed as if from the time of its passing section I thereof had read as amended by the last preceding section, and particularly therefore
 - (a) the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of August 1927;
 - (b) all rules which purport to have been duly made under the said Ordinance before the passing of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have been validly made as from the date of their making;
 - (c) all pensions gratuities and allowances granted in accordance with the said rules shall be deemed to have been validly and properly paid on and from the time at which they were paid; and
 - (d) all other acts and things that purport to have been done by virtue of the provisions of the said Ordinance or rules shall on and from the time at which they were so done be deemed to have been validly and properly done, and such acts and things shall in all respects be as valid and effectual as if the said Ordinance had come into operation on the first day of August 1927.

Objects and Reasons.

The School Teachers' Pension Ordinance, No. 6 of 1927, had to be brought into force by a Proclamation under section 1 fixing the date on which it was to come into operation. Though such a proclamation does not appear to have been issued the Ordinance has been acted upon as if it had come into operation on the 1st of August 1927 when it received the assent of the Governor. This Ordinance therefore seeks to validate all matters done on the basis that the principal Ordinance became law on that date. Clause 1 accordingly amends section 1 by fixing the 1st of August 1927 as the time at which the principal Ordinance came in the principal ordinance came in the principal ordinance are the principal ordinance are the principal ordinance and clause 2 specifically ratifies all acts which purport to have been done in pursuance of the powers under the principal Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

The second proviso to section 5 (1) of "The Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895," does not permit of the appointment of an Office Assistant to a Government Agent as an Assistant Provincial Registrar. It has been usual, however, to so appoint such an Office Assistant and it would be inconvenient now to discontinue the practice. The present amendment is therefore designed to legalize such appointments.
