DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance for making provision for the Public, Railway and Colombo Electricity Supply services for the financial year 1931-32.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance of 1931.

Appropriation for the year 1931-32.

2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding eighty-three million and thirty-three thousand one hundred and ten rupees, twenty-seven million rupees, and two million one hundred and fifty thousand rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1931, and ending on September 30, 1932, out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the schedules to this Ordinance.
