DRAFT ORDINANCE.**MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Land Settlement Ordinance, 1931.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Land Settlement Amendment Ordinance, 1931.

Amendment of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 4 (3) of the Land Settlement Ordinance, 1931 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is repealed and the following is substituted therefor :—

"(3) Whenever the extent of the land or the aggregate extent of the lands, if more than one, to which any settlement notice relates exceeds ten acres, a notification as near as possible in form No. 4 in the First Schedule shall be published once at least in any two of the newspapers published in Ceylon, one of which shall be a newspaper published in Sinhalese or Tamil, in the language in which such newspaper is published."

Amendment of section 5 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 5 (6) of the principal Ordinance is amended by the substitution of the words "The Minister for Agriculture and Lands" for the word "Governor" occurring in lines 4 and 8.

Amendment of First Schedule.

4 The First Schedule of the principal Ordinance is amended as follows :—

(a) By substituting for Form No. 3 therein the following :—

Objects and Reasons.

(a) When a settlement notice under the Settlement Ordinance is published various means of making it widely known are laid down. They are :—

- (1) Publication in the Gazette.
- (2) Posting up of copies on or near the land to which the notice relates.
- (3) Affixing of copies on the walls of Kachcheries and Courts of the Province including the Courts of Village Tribunals and the customary meeting places of those Village Committees which have power to punish breaches of Village Committee rules.
- (4) Publication by beat of tom-tom in the village on or near the land.
- (5) Service of a copy of the notice on every person known to be interested in the lands.
- (6) Publication in two newspapers when the extent of the land exceeds ten acres.

The cost to Government of publication under item (6) above is about Rs. 40,000 a year but it is believed that very few claimants obtain their knowledge of the existence of a notice from the newspaper advertisements. Most careful enquiries are made by the Settlement Officer in the village as to the names of all claimants and interested persons, and there is special provision for the service of a copy of the notice on every claimant or interested person. In these circumstances the publication in two newspapers of the entire notice, often many columns in length and referring individually to several hundreds of lands, appears to be a sheer waste of money.

It has therefore been suggested that instead of advertising the entire notice, a short note should be published in the newspapers stating that a settlement notice relating to lands in a specified village has been published in the Gazette of a given date and that further information can be obtained at the Settlement office. This suggestion, if adopted will probably result in a saving to Government of about Rs. 38,000 a year, while at the same time a newspaper reader will be in a position to obtain as much information as he used to do in the past.

(b) Under the old constitution the consent of the Governor to any settlement was largely a formal matter which followed as a matter of routine the approval of a settlement by the Controller of Revenue and the Attorney-General. Under the new constitution this consent may with advantage be exercised by the Minister for Agriculture and Lands. The proposed amendment would obviate the necessity of sending all the files to His Excellency the Governor and tend to expedite despatch of public business.

(c) The reference in Form No. 3 in the First Schedule in the principal ordinance to the lot and plan number entails a large amount of clerical labour and its inclusion is unnecessary as the information already appears in the schedule to Form 2 in the First Schedule in the principal Ordinance.

The post of Colonial Secretary does not exist under the new constitution. His functions in connection with this certificate may properly be discharged by the Land Commissioner.
