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MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on
Friday, December 14, 1894. ✓

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated December 8, 1894.

Present :—Mr. C. E. D. Pennycook, Mayor and Chairman; Hon. Sir J. J. Grinlinton; Dr. W. R. Kynsey; C.M.G.; Hon. R. K. MacBride, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Captain F. Bayley; Mr. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of November 16 and December 7, 1894, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of 16th November and 7th December, 1894, be confirmed.

1. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to November 30, 1894, and a Progress Report of Work done during November, 1894, were laid on the table.

2. A letter No. 168 of November 27, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, forwarding copy of a report from the Ceylon National Association on the amendment of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, was laid before the Council after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the Hon. the Colonial Secretary be requested to lay the report of the Ceylon National Association before the Sub-Committee of the Legislative Council now sitting for the purpose of considering amendments to the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, and to invite their careful consideration of the suggestions made in the report.

Resolved further, at the suggestion of Mr. C. Perera, that the reports made by the Special Committees of the Municipal Council on the Chairman's Administration Reports since the passing of Ordinance 7 of 1887, containing suggestions for the amendment of the Ordinance, be also forwarded to the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, to be considered with the report of the National Association.

3. A letter No. 166 of November 14, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, proposing an extension of the Municipal limits, was laid before the Council after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the suggestion contained in the above letter be accepted, and that the new boundaries be as follows :—The eastern and northern limit to be the point where the railway bridge crosses the Kelani river. From there the railway line to be the boundary to the point where it crosses the Demetagoda-ela. From there the Demetagoda-ela to be the boundary to the point where it crosses the Kotte road (just east of the 4th milepost).

From thence the boundary to follow the line of the water-course which skirts the Alfred Model Farm on its south-east side to the point where the water-course crosses the North and South Base line road. The Base line road to be the boundary from this point to the Kirilapane canal, and the Kirilapane canal to be the boundary from this to the present southern limit of the Municipality. That these boundaries be marked on the map received from the Surveyor-General with his letter No. 43 of December 13, 1894, and the plan forwarded to Government when returned by the Surveyor-General.

4. A letter No. 165 of November 14, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, forwarding one from His Excellency the General Officer Commanding the Troops with reference to danger to Military buildings from fire, was laid before the Council after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the Hon. the Colonial Secretary be informed that the Council are of opinion that the provision already made by them for dealing with fires is sufficient for the requirements of the town.

5. A further letter No. 171 of December 1, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the boundary wall of Queen's House, was laid before the Council after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the Council agree to the proposal contained in the above letter.

6. A letter dated October 10, 1894, from certain Hindu residents of Colombo with reference to the opening of an additional cremation ground, was laid before the Council.

Resolved at the request of Hon. P. Coomaraswamy, who was unable to be present at this Meeting, that the consideration of the above letter be deferred.

7. A petition dated November 16, 1894, from I. L. M. H. Noordeen Hadjiyar, a resident of New Moor street, complaining of the inconvenience caused by the want of water service to his house, was laid before the Council. A letter No. 163 of November 27 (28) from the Director of Public Works, to whom the above petition was referred, was also laid before the Council, intimating that the house in question had a frontage on the street boundary with a standpost about three yards from the door, and that it was not considered advisable to sanction a separate house service in this instance.

Resolved,—That the petitioner be so informed.

8. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for August, 1894, received with letter No. 126 of November 28, 1894, were laid on the table.

9. A remark by the Auditor-General on the Kanatta Cemetery Keeper's accounts for July to September, 1894, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That rule 8 of the Regulations under "The Municipal Cemeteries Ordinance, 1894," adopted on July 13, 1894, be amended by the insertion of the words "Fee to the keeper" in the three last lines, as follows :—
