GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

Arrack Tavern Licence—Amendment to.

THE Governor under section 24 of "The Excise Ordinance, No. 8 of 1912," directs that in respect of arrack rents sold on and after the date hereof, the following be substituted for condition No. 1 (b) of the arrack tavern licence form appearing in Excise Notification No. 216 published in *Government Gazette* No. 7,837 of March 20, 1931:—

- (b) Shall not sell arrack in sealed white 8 dram bottles at a rate exceeding Rs. 2'75 per bottle.
- (c) Shall not sell arrack in sealed 6 dram black bottles at a lower rate than Rs. 2'05 each nor in sealed pint bottles at a lower rate than Re. 1'40 each:

Provided that the Government Agent may for special reasons and on the application of the licensee permit the sale of arrack in the case of white 8 dram bottles at such rates exceeding the rate hereinbefore set forth, and in the case of 6 dram black bottles and pint bottles at such rates lower than the rates hereinbefore set forth as he may in his discretion determine.
