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DRAFT ORDINANCES.**MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Births and Deaths Registration Amendment Ordinance, 1931.

Amendment of section 32A of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 32A of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, 1895, is amended by the addition of the following words at the end of sub-section (2) :—

“Such removal may however precede the registration of death when the death has occurred in a Government Hospital.”

Objects and Reasons.

The dead body of a person dying in a town proclaimed under sections 31 to 36 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1895 cannot, under the existing law, be removed from such town for burial or cremation elsewhere until after the registration of the death. The object of this requirement is to ensure the registration of every death and the certification of its true cause.

2. The Director of Medical and Sanitary Services has represented that much inconvenience and annoyance is caused to the relatives of patients dying in Government hospitals owing to delays experienced in obtaining permits for removal of dead bodies from towns out of the office hours of the registrar, especially in Colombo and Galle where the registrar's office is over a mile distant from the hospital.

3. It is therefore proposed to modify the requirement in section 32A (2) by permitting, before registration, the removal of bodies of persons dying in Government hospitals. The object of this modification is to avoid inconvenience to the public without impairing registration. Deaths in Government hospitals are reported for registration by the Medical Officer in Charge who also certifies to the actual cause of death. This practice will continue and thus no death in a Government hospital will escape registration.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Ordinance, 1895.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Ordinance Amendment Ordinance, 1931.

2 In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, “the principal Ordinance” shall mean The Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Ordinance, 1895.

3 Section 2 of the principal Ordinance shall be deleted and in lieu thereof the following shall be substituted :—

2 The general objects for which the Corporation is constituted are hereby declared to be :—

(a) to promote, foster, and protect the commerce of Ceylon by collecting and classifying all information bearing on its wants and interests, by obtaining by every means the redress of acknowledged grievances and the removal of pernicious restrictions, by controlling or regulating all or any matters concerning the sale,

- purchase or shipment of produce, and manufactured or prepared products and goods, as between members of the Corporation, and generally by any other means howsoever not herein specified ;*
- (b) *to represent and express on commercial questions the opinions of the mercantile community of Ceylon and to aid, assist and co-operate with others in such representation and expression ;*
 - (c) *the consideration of all questions connected with the trade, manufactures and industries of Ceylon ;*
 - (d) *to endeavour to promote or oppose legislative and other measures affecting such trade, manufactures and industries ;*
 - (e) *to collect and circulate statistics and other information relating to such trade, manufactures and industries ;*
 - (f) *to decide disputes and differences on matters of local custom and usage, and to form a court of reconciliation and of arbitration to parties willing to abide by its decisions and to undertake the settlement of disputes and differences arising out of trade commerce and industry ;*
 - (g) *to advise and communicate on matters of trade commerce and industry with the public authorities, with similar associations in other places, and with individuals ;*
 - (h) *by recording its proceedings and decisions, to form a code of practice by which transactions of business may be simplified and facilitated ;*
 - (i) *to undertake and execute any trusts, and to undertake the office of trustee, and to co-operate with executors and trustees in the financial administration of any estate or trust and to transact or carry on all kinds of business relating to trusts ;*
 - (j) *to establish and support Provident Funds for the benefit of the officers, employees and servants of the Corporation ;*
 - (k) *to borrow or raise money for the purposes of the Corporation and for that purpose or for securing money for the performance or discharge of any obligation or liability of the Corporation or for any other purpose to create execute grant or issue any mortgages, mortgage debentures, debenture stock, bonds or obligations of the Corporation and to pay off and re-borrow the moneys secured thereby or any part or parts thereof ;*
 - (l) *to do all or any of the above things in any parts of the world, and either as principals, agents, trustees or otherwise, and by agents, trustees or otherwise and either alone or in conjunction with others ;*
 - (m) *to do all such other things as may be necessary incidental or conducive to the interests or benefit of the mercantile community of Ceylon or to the attainment of the above objects or any of them or generally to the benefit protection or advancement of the trade commerce manufactures and industries of Ceylon ;*
 - (n) *to enter into sign and execute any contracts agreements and other documents for the purpose of nominating or appointing any person or persons whomsoever as representative or agent of the Corporation or for the purpose of delegating any matters to any person or persons whomsoever or otherwise for all or any of the purposes aforesaid either in Ceylon or abroad.*

It is hereby further declared that the objects specified in each paragraph of this section shall be independent main objects, and shall not be limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraph.

4 Section 3 (1) of the principal Ordinance shall be deleted and in lieu thereof the following shall be substituted :—

3 (1) The affairs of the Corporation shall be administered, subject to the Rules for the time being of the Corporation as hereinafter provided, by a Committee consisting of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman respectively and the Deputy Chairman (if any) of the Corporation and not less than five members of the Corporation to be elected respectively in accordance with the Rules for the time being of the Corporation, with power to such Committee to delegate the administration of any portion or portions of the affairs of the Corporation to one or more sub-Committees.

5 Section 4 (1) of the principal Ordinance shall be amended by the substitution of the words "The Committee" in place of the words "The Board of Directors" in the first line thereof.

6 Section 5 of the principal Ordinance shall be deleted and in lieu thereof the following shall be substituted :—

5 It shall be lawful for the Corporation from time to time, at any General Meeting of the Members, and by a majority of votes to make Rules and pass resolutions for the admission, withdrawal, or expulsion of Members ; for the imposition of fines and forfeitures for breaches of Rules ; for the appointment and the conduct of the duties of the Committee and the appointment and the conduct of the duties of and the payment of remuneration to the various officers, representatives, agents, and servants of the Corporation either in Ceylon or abroad ; for the expenditure and disposal of the funds of the Corporation ; for the procedure in the transaction of business ; and otherwise generally for the management of the affairs of the Corporation and the accomplishment of its objects. Such Rules when made may, at a like Meeting, be altered, added to, amended, or cancelled subject, however, to the requirements of section 7.

7 The following words shall be added at the end of section 8 :—

Provided always that any property movable or immovable heretofore or hereafter acquired or held by the Corporation upon trusts or subject to conditions in any grant or testamentary disposition contained or otherwise as trustee, shall be held by the Corporation upon the trusts or subject to the conditions aforesaid or otherwise upon such trusts as may be imposed upon the Corporation with regard to such property.

8 Section 10 of the principal Ordinance shall be amended as follows :—

- (a) by the substitution of the words "the Committee" in lieu of the words "the Board of Directors" in the third line thereof
- (b) by the addition of the following words at the end of the section to wit :— "Any instrument sealed with the seal of the corporation and signed by two members of the Committee shall be presumed to be duly executed."

9 Section 11 of the principal Ordinance shall be deleted and in lieu thereof the following shall be substituted :—

11 The Corporation shall be able and capable in law to take and hold either as beneficial owner or as trustee or otherwise any property, movable or immovable, upon or by virtue of any instrument of purchase, grant, gift, or lease, or upon or by virtue of any testamentary disposition or otherwise, and all such property shall be held by the Corporation (a) for the purposes of this Ordinance and subject to the Rules for the time being of the said Corporation or (b) otherwise for the purposes of and upon the trusts and subject to the conditions in the relative instrument or disposition contained, with full power (subject always to the provisions of the relative instrument or disposition) to sell, mortgage, lease, exchange, or otherwise dispose of, encumber, or charge the same.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

It has been felt for some time past that The Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Ordinance of 1895 requires modification in several respects if it is to be brought into line with modern conditions, the expansion and development of trade and commerce in Ceylon, and the Chamber's present and future activities. Just as in the case of limited Companies, the objects thereof and the powers of Directors have within recent years been considerably enlarged, it is felt that, though the Ordinance of 1895 doubtless was sufficient to meet conditions as they existed at the time, the objects and powers of the Chamber should be similarly enlarged. This bill is intended to supply the required modifications.

Section 2 of the principal Ordinance defined the general objects of the Chamber. It is desired that these objects should be more clearly defined and extended so as to be consistent with the activities of the Chamber under modern conditions. The suggested amendments in section 3 of the amending Ordinance have, in part, been adopted from the recognized objects of similar institutions (*vide* Butterworth's

Encyclopaedia of Forms & Precedents, 1908 Ed., Vol. XIV. p. 425); while other suggested amendments will enable the Chamber to act as trustee, for example, of its Provident Fund or of a general Provident Fund for the benefit of members of the mercantile community or the staffs of mercantile firms, or otherwise as trustee.

The activities of the Chamber are of such diversity that a division of labour in Committee-work has been found necessary, while it is also thought that the imposition of a maximum on the number of Committee members creates difficulties in practice. Section 4 of the amending Ordinance, while making a verbal alteration in re-naming the "Board of Directors" as the "Committee" (which is felt to be more practical), proceeds to empower the distribution of work among sub-Committees, without creating a maximum number of Committee members.

Section 5 of the principal Ordinance authorizes the Chamber to make its own Rules for certain specified purposes, but it does not appear to authorize the Chamber to remunerate its officers or representatives or otherwise to dispose of its funds. While this power is one that may perhaps be implied, section 6 of the amending Ordinance is intended to formally supply the omission, while the opportunity is taken to make certain minor verbal amendments in section 5 of the principal Ordinance.

Consequent upon the Chamber being empowered to act as a trustee, formal amendments become necessary to sections 8 and 11 of the principal Ordinance.

The suggested amendments in section 8 of the amending Ordinance are purely formal.
