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## DRAFT ORDINANCES.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910."

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, 1931.

Amendment of section 23 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 23 of The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is amended in line 1 by substituting for the word "twenty" the word "ten".

Amendment of section 45 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 45 of the principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end of sub-section (1) (k) the words "and establishing and maintaining public libraries within the Municipality".

Amendment of section 110 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 110 of the principal Ordinance is amended as follows:—

(A) By adding at the end of sub-section (5) the following:—

- "(g) The regulation and control of swine.
- (h) The prevention of malaria and the destruction of mosquitoes and disease bearing insects.
- (i) The licensing, regulation, inspection and control of stables and cattle galas."

(B) By adding at the end the following:—

"(21) The regulation and control of advertisements displayed or exhibited so as to be visible from any street, road, canal or lake, and the charging of fees for the same.

(22) The establishment, maintenance, working and supply, and the recovery of charges in connection therewith of the following:—

- (a) Water supply.
- (b) The lighting of streets, public places, and public buildings.
- (c) The supply of electric light or power.
- (d) Markets.
- (e) Public baths and bathing places.
- (f) Any other form of public service which the Council is authorized to establish, maintain, or provide under any other provision of this Ordinance or under any by-laws to be made thereunder.
- (g) Any other form of public service which the Council may be specially authorized to establish, maintain, or provide for by the Executive Committee of Local Administration."

Amendment of section 120 of the principal Ordinance.

5 Section 120 of the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting for the words "and shall be liable on conviction thereof to a fine not exceeding fifty rupees" in lines 21 and 22 the words "and shall be liable on summary conviction thereof to a fine not exceeding five hundred rupees".

Insertion of new section 124A in the principal Ordinance.

6 Between section 124 and 125 of the principal Ordinance the following new section 124A is inserted:—

Revision of assessment on alteration of property affecting annual value.

"124A Where physical alterations affecting the annual value of any house, building, land, or tenement are made after the assessment in respect of them for any year has become final by virtue of the preceding sections the Council may notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said sections at any time prepare a new assessment for such premises which shall come into force from the first day of the month following that in which it is entered in the assessment book, provided always that such new assessments shall as far as possible be made in the manner prescribed by the said sections and be subject to the objections, investigations, actions, and appeals referred to therein".

Amendment of section 153 of the principal Ordinance.

7 Section 153 (1) of the principal Ordinance is amended by deleting the words "by public auction" in line 2.

Amendment of section 156 of the principal Ordinance.

8 Section 156 of the principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end the words "or from allowing the putting up of sunshades and any other similar projections."

9 Immediately after section 187 of the principal Ordinance the following new section 187A is inserted :—

Insertion of new section 187A in the principal Ordinance.

“ 187A (1) It shall be lawful for the Council to name or rename any street and to paint up or otherwise mark the name of any street and the number of any house or tenement on any private property and any person who without the authority of the Council removes or alters any such name or number shall be guilty of an offence.

Power to paint names of streets and houses on private property.

(2) For the purposes of this section and of section 45 (1) (e) the word “ street ” shall include any road, footway or passage used or intended to be used as a means of access to two or more houses or sites of houses whether the public have a right of way thereover or not and any side-walk and reservation at the side thereof.”

10 Section 236 of the principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end the words “ provided that in respect of an offence under section 120 the complaint may be made at any time within twelve months next after its commission ”.

Amendment of section 236 of the principal Ordinance.

11 Schedule D of the principal Ordinance is amended by inserting between the word “ wheelbarrows ” and the word “ and ” in line 13 the words “ hand carts used for trade purposes solely within private premises ”.

Amendment of Schedule D of the principal Ordinance.

#### *Objects and Reasons.*

The purpose of this Bill is to make various alterations in The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, which experience has shown to be necessary for its proper working.

2. Clause 2 lowers the minimum number of votes which a candidate must receive before he can be elected a Councillor.

3. Clause 3 permits a Council to expend money on the establishment and maintenance of public libraries.

4. Clause 4 extends the topics on which a Council may make by-laws.

5. Clause 5 increases the penalty for a breach of the offence under section 120, and clause 11 limits the period within which a prosecution can be filed in respect of such an offence.

6. Clause 6 entitles a Council to revise at any time the annual assessment, if since the assessment for the year was made the premises have been subjected to a change which has altered the annual value.

7. Clause 7 removes the requirement that a sale of lands and buildings belonging to a Council shall be by public auction.

8. Clause 8 authorizes the erection of sunshades encroaching over any street or lake if this is done with the permission of the Chairman of the Council.

9. Clause 9 empowers a Council to name roads whether public or private and to mark such roads with names and to mark houses and tenements with numbers.

10. Clause 11 exempts from tax hand carts used for trade within private premises.

#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend “ The Colombo Municipal Council Waterworks Ordinance, 1907.”**

**BE** it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Colombo Municipal Waterworks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931, and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor may by proclamation published in the Gazette appoint.

Short title and commencement.

2 Section 8 of the Colombo Municipal Waterworks Ordinance, 1907, (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Ordinance ”) is amended in line 3 by inserting between the word “ Government ” and the word “ which ” therein the words “ and of His Majesty’s Forces ”.

Amendment of section 8 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 9 of the principal Ordinance is repealed.

Repeal of section 9 of the principal Ordinance.

*Objects and Reasons.*

The Municipal Waterworks Amendment Ordinance, 1930, was passed to give effect to Government's new financial arrangement with the Colombo Municipality, regarding the supply of water for the use of Government; but at the time this arrangement was made it was not noticed that under section 9 of the Ordinance a sum of Rs. 12,500 per annum is payable by the War Department to the Colombo Municipality for supply of water to military buildings.

2. Since the Government has undertaken to pay a contribution in lieu of rates on naval and military buildings, and since the greater proportion of the water supplied to military buildings would be covered (as being water used for domestic purposes) by this contribution, the Municipality has agreed that the new arrangement should apply to military buildings as well, and that section 9 of Ordinance No. 18 of 1907 should be repealed. This Bill therefore seeks to make the amendments necessitated by this new agreement.

## MINUTE.

The following draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

**An Ordinance to enable a temporary levy to be imposed on the salaries and wages of persons employed in the public service.**

Short title.	1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Temporary Levy on Salaries of Public Servants (Enabling) Ordinance, 1931.
Authority to impose temporary levy on salaries and wages of public servants.	2 (1) Whenever the Governor considers that, for the purpose of assisting in the maintenance of the financial stability of the Island, it is expedient to impose, for the benefit of the public revenue, a temporary levy on the salaries and wages of persons employed in the public service, he may, by Order issued with the prior approval of the Secretary of State, authorize the deduction from the salaries and wages payable to such of the persons aforesaid as the Order shall specify a sum calculated in such manner as the Order shall prescribe.
The first Order may be retrospective.	(2) The first Order issued under this section may declare that it shall be deemed to have come into operation on a date prior to the date on which it is issued, provided that such Order shall not come into operation, or be deemed to have come into operation, on a date prior to the first day of February, 1932.
Period of operation to be stated in Order.	(3) An Order issued under this section shall state the period for which it is to remain in operation unless previously revoked, provided that nothing in this sub-section shall prejudice the amendment of any Order during the period of its operation or the issue of any new Order to take effect on or at any time after the expiration of any preceding Order.
Deductions to be credited to revenue.	3 All deductions from salaries or wages made under any Order authorized by the preceding section shall be credited to the general revenue, or to the revenue of the service to which such salaries or wages are primarily chargeable, in such manner as the Order shall prescribe.
Deductions not to affect pensions or gratuities or contributions required by Ordinance No. 1 of 1898.	4 No deduction from salaries or wages made under any Order authorized by section 2 shall be taken into account in the calculation of any pension or gratuity based on salaries or wages, or in the calculation of any abatement of salary required by the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, 1898, or by any Ordinance amending or substituted for that Ordinance.

*Objects and Reasons.*

The object of this Bill is to enable the Governor, with the prior approval of the Secretary of State, to impose a temporary levy on the salaries and wages of public servants whenever he shall consider it expedient to do so for the maintenance of the financial stability of the Island.

2. The method of calculating the levy, and consequently its amount, as well as the classes of public servants from whose salaries or wages it will be deducted, will be prescribed by the Governor with the prior approval of the Secretary of State.

3. An Order imposing a levy may be retrospective to a date not anterior to the 1st February, 1932, the date on which it is intended that the levy shall take effect. This provision is necessary to meet the possibility that the Secretary of State's approval of the details of the levy may not be obtained before that date.

4. Every Order must state the period for which it is to remain in force, but an Order may be amended at any time or renewed at any time with or without amendment.

5. The levy will not affect pensions or gratuities based on salaries or wages, or payments, based on salary, required by the Ordinances relating to the Widows and Orphans Pensions Fund or Scheme. For the purpose of calculating those payments, salaries and wages will be taken at the rate at which they would have been payable if the levy had not been imposed. To enable a deduction to be made from salaries or wages which for certain purposes remain at a higher figure than is actually paid, legislative authority is necessary.

6. The amount of the levy will be credited either to the general revenue, or to the revenue of the Railway or of the Colombo Electricity Supply, according to whether the salary or wages from which the levy is deducted is primarily chargeable to one or other of those sources.
