Kurunegala S. O. No. 4,863.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Diulgahamulahena, Kolongahamulahena, situate in the village of Alankarayagama, in the Tissawa korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927.

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 11th day of November, 1927, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Diulgahamulahena, Kolongahamulahena, situate in the village of Alankarayagama, in the Tissawa korale of the Dewamedi hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 5 acres 2 roods and 20 perches, and shown as lot 8 in block survey preliminary plan No. 2,298, was made to Norman John Luddington, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 9,662):

O. T. Ps. (L. L. L. No. 3,539).
