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## FINAL ORDERS.

## Trincomalee S. O. No. 37.

Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Chammavachchathieuukadu, cart track and reservation, &c., situate in the village of Periyakinniyai, in the Tampalakam pattu of the Tampalakam division of the Trincomalee District, in the Eastern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."
