FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927," declaring Land to be the Crown Property in Absence of Claim.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Uppukali, situate in the village of Andankani in Akkarai pattu north of Kalpitiya division, in the Puttalam District of the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."
