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ORDERS. FINAL

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927, declaring Purchase of Land.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Ambanellahena, situate in the village of Maussagolla in the Matale Pallesiya pattuwa of the Matale East, Matale District, in the Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927.'

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 9th day of January, 1931, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Ambanellahona, situate in the village of Maussagolla in the Matale Pallesiya pattuwa of the Matale District, in the Central Province, containing in extent 1 acre 1 rood and 13 perches, and shown as lot 40 in preliminary plan No. 8,055 was made to the Assistant Government Agent, Matale District, Central Province, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown (vide Notice No. 10,801):

And whereas Ponniah Peiris and Stanislaus Costa, both of Matale made claim thereto, and Charles Ernest Jones, Esq., Assistant Government Agent of the Matale District, Central Province, made due inquiry into such claim; and whereas the said claimants and I came to an agreement in writing dated June 22, 1931, concerning the said land,

under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said claimants should be declared the purchasers of the said land, upon payment on or before July 22,1931, to the Assistant Government Agent of Matale at Matale Kachchori of a sum of Rupees Thirty-nine and Cents Ninety-four (Rs. 39 94) only, as the pur-chase amount of the said land; and whereas the said amount has been duly paid by the said claimants, they are hereby, in pursuance of the agreement aforementioned, declared on this 17th day of October, 1931, to be the purchasers of the said land, as more fully described herein below, and in the survey and description thereof authenticated by Arthur Harry Gerald Dawson, Esq., Surveyor-General, bearing date the 30th September, 1931, No. 417,125/F. O. T. P.
