## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, January 11, 1895.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated January 5, 1895.

*Present*:—Mr. C. E. D. Pennycuik, Mayor and Chairman; Dr. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Hon. R. K. MacBride, C.M.G.; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of December 14, 1894, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of December 14, 1894, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. M. Fernando moved “that in view of the large excess of the supply of water at the reservoir over the consumption, the Council is of opinion that the present restrictions in regard to house connections should be modified, and that Government be informed accordingly.”

Mr. Alvis seconded.

In view of a statement made by the Director of Public Works regarding the removal of some of the present restrictions, this motion was, by leave of Council, withdrawn.

2. The Council then proceeded to ballot for the election of five members to form a Standing Committee for 1895, in accordance with the 88th section of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, and the result of the ballot was declared by the Chairman to be in favour of Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna, Mr. C. P. Dias, Dr. W. R. Kynsey, Mr. C. Perera, and Mr. C. M. Fernando, who, with the Chairman, were thereupon appointed a Standing Committee for 1895.

3. The Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to December 31, 1894, and the Progress Report of Work done during December, were not ready.

4. A letter No. 181 of December 31, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, was laid before the Council, intimating that the Lieut.-Governor in Council sees no ground for objection to the proposed extension of the Municipal limits, provided the persons interested in the territory proposed to be included have no good cause to show against the measure, and that the grass land and marshes to be included are not unduly taxed for police, lighting, and water.

Resolved,—That it be pointed out, in reply to the above letter, that the proposal for extending the Municipal limits emanated from the Government; that the Council have no means of ascertaining the wishes of the people; and that they have no power to exempt grass lands from assessment under the provisions of the Ordinance 7 of 1887.

Resolved further,—That the additions to the limits shown in the plan returned with the Colonial Secretary's letter as affecting the different divisions, No. 6, No. 7, and No. 9 (New Bazaar, Maradana, and Kollupitiya), be adopted.

5. Resolved that the assessment of properties within the Municipality contained in the books for 1894 be adopted for 1895, with such alterations as may be deemed necessary, in terms of section 139 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887.

6. A resolution of the Standing Committee of December 21, 1894, recommending that the pay and allowance for November of the late Chief Municipal Inspector, Mr. Jayetileke (who died on November 6, 1894), be paid in full to his widow, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the resolution of the Standing Committee be approved.

7. The letter dated October 10, presented by Hon. P. Coomaraswamy at the Meeting of November 16, 1894, with reference to the opening of an additional cremation ground, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the Chairman be authorized to endeavour to obtain from Government a piece of land suitable for the purpose of a cremation ground.

8. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for September, 1894, were not received.

9. A remark by the Auditor-General on the expenditure on vouchers Nos. 1,356, 1,339, 1,419, and 1,433 for December, 1892, and a remark on the accounts for July, 1893, on check roll No. 24 for June, 1893, were laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the excess in each case over the items allowed in the respective estimates be sanctioned.

10. The City Analyst's report dated January 8, 1895, on the town water for December, 1894, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

11. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for January, 1895, were laid on the table.

12. Resolved that the Special Committee appointed on December 7, 1894, on the question of additional remuneration to Municipal Officers, and consisting of the Chairman, Captain F. Bayley, Mr. C. P. Dias, Hon. P. Coomaraswamy, Mr. C. Perera, and Mr. R. H. Morgan, three members to form a quorum—be re-appointed, in view of the proviso to section 100 of Ordinance 7 of 1887.

13. An application dated January 5, 1895, from Mr. L. P. Billimoria, on behalf of the Elphinstone Theatrical Company, to put up a building in the Racquet Court for a theatrical entertainment, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved "that the application be allowed subject to payment of the usual fees."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.
