DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend The Chanks Ordinance, 1890.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Chanks (Amendment) Ordinance, 193 .

Insertion of section 7 in the principal Ordinance.

2 The Chanks Ordinance 1890 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is amended by the insertion of the following section 7 :—

Power to declare a chank fishery camp.

7 (1) The Governor may, with the advice of the Minister for Health, from time to time by notification in the Government Gazette declare any place to be a chank fishery camp for the purpose of chank fishery, and may appoint any person to be camp superintendent thereof. A notification under this section may be amended from time to time.

(2) A place declared to be a chank fishery camp shall be deemed to be a chank fishery camp within the meaning of this Ordinance for one month before the commencement of, during the continuance of, and for one month after the termination of the fishery for which the camp is established.

Insertion of new section 7A in the principal Ordinance.

3 The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the following new section 7A between section 7 and section 8 :—

Regulations and penalty.

7A (1) The Executive Committee of Health may make regulations in respect of any chank fishery for preserving order, for preventing accidents, fire and disease, for regulating water supply, sanitation, and food prices and for any other matter or thing whatsoever, whether similar to those before enumerated or not, which the said Committee considers necessary or convenient for the proper administration of a chank fishery camp. Any person who contravenes or attempts to contravene or abets the contravention of any regulation made under this section shall be guilty of an offence and, on conviction by a police magistrate, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees.

(2) Notwithstanding section 9 (2) no regulation made under this section shall have effect unless it has been approved by the State Council and ratified by the Governor. Notification of such approval and ratification shall be published in the Government Gazette and no regulation shall come into operation until the date of the publication of such notification.

Objects and Reasons.

Every year over a thousand chank fishers come over to Ceylon from India and elsewhere for the purpose of fishing for chanks. In places which they make the base for their operations they have in recent years come into conflict with the local inhabitants over the use of the limited water supply of the villages and because of their not always sanitary habits. The existing powers for village administration have proved inadequate for dealing with the situation, and there is constant danger of a serious breach of the peace or an outbreak of disease at the encampments. This Bill therefore seeks to control chank fishery camps on lines familiar in the case of the pearl fisheries.
