Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 2 of 1933.

An Ordinance to amend the Medical Ordinance, 1927.

GRAEME THOMSON.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Medical Amendment Ordinance, No. 2 of 1933.
2 Section 65 of the Medical Ordinance, 1927 (hereinafter)

Amendment of section 65 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 65 of the Medical Ordinance, 1927, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "shall be paid into general revenue, and" in the first and second lines thereof.

Repeal of section 68 of the principal Ordinance and substitution of a new section

therefor.

- 3 Section 68 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:
 - 68 For the purpose of defraying such expenses as may be incurred in the exercise of its powers and in the performance of its duties under this Ordinance, the Medical Council shall be entitled to receive—
 - (1) all fees payable under Chapters V, VI, VII, VIII, and IX of this Ordinance;
 - (2) a sum of one thousand five hundred rupees annually from general revenue.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend the Medical Ordinance, 1927.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Medical Amendment Ordinance, 1933.

Amendment of section 51 of the principal Ordinance.

- 2 Section 51 of the Medical Ordinance 1927 is amended as follows:—
 - (a) Sub-section (1) (a) by the insertion of the words "or surgeon dentist" between the word "surgeon" and the word "or" in line 2 thereof.
 - (b) Sub-section (2) by the addition of the words "and shall not assume or use the titles of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist unless he possesses the qualifications indicated in section 45 (1) (a) and section 45 (1) (b)."

Objects and Reasons.

As the titles of "Dental Surgeon" and "Surgeon Dentist" are generally accepted to describe either persons registered under the Dentists Acts 1878 of the United Kingdom or those holding the Ceylon Medical Council's diploma in dentistry, this Bill is designed to prevent the assumption and use of these titles by dentists who do not possess the qualifications mentioned.
