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**DRAFT ORDINANCES.****MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 9 of 1872, entitled “ An Ordinance to empower Commissioners, appointed by the Governor to inquire into any matter referred to them for inquiry, to hear evidence thereon.”**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as “ The Commissions of Inquiry Ordinance, 1933 ”.

Insertion of new section 5 in Ordinance No. 9 of 1872.

2 At the end of Ordinance No. 9 of 1872, entitled “ An Ordinance to empower Commissioners, appointed by the Governor to inquire into any matter referred to them for inquiry, to hear evidence thereon,” the following new section 5 is added :—

Persons affected by Inquiries may be represented by advocates or proctors.

5 Any person whose conduct is the subject of inquiry under this Ordinance, or who is in any way implicated or concerned in the matter under inquiry, shall be entitled to be represented by one or more advocates or proctors at the whole of the inquiry, and any other person who may consider it desirable that he should be so represented may, by leave of the Commissioners, be represented in the manner aforesaid.

*Objects and Reasons.*

The Commissions of Inquiry Ordinance, No. 9 of 1872, gives no right of representation by advocate or proctor to person whose conduct is the subject of an inquiry or is likely to be criticised in the course of an inquiry. It has been the practice of Commissions to permit such persons to be legally represented, but it is considered desirable that definite provisions for representation should be made by law. Representation by proctors as well as by advocates is authorised in order to obviate possible difficulties in localities in which representation by an advocate may be difficult to secure.

**MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Municipal Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933.

Amendment of section 147 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 147 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910 (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Ordinance ”) is amended as follows :—

(a) Sub-section (2) is repealed and the following is substituted therefor :

“ (2) Any surplus accruing from any such sale and conveyance (whether made and executed before or after the enactment of this sub-section) shall after deducting the amounts and costs specified in sub-section (5) be paid on demand (a) to the *fidei commissary* where the land or immovable property is subject to a *fidei commissum* and (b) to the person entitled to the land or immovable property in all other cases.

(b) Sub-section (3) is renumbered as sub-section (4) and the word “ ten ” is substituted for the word “ six ” in line 1 thereof.

(c) Sub-section (4) is renumbered sub-section (5).

(d) The following is inserted as sub-section (3) :—

“ (3) No such surplus shall be so paid unless the said demand is made within ten years of the date of the sale and conveyance. Provided that where the surplus is payable either to a *fidei commissary* who is not entitled to

possession at that date or to a person who is then a minor, the said period shall not commence to run until the right to possess accrues or majority is attained respectively."

(e) The following is inserted as sub-section (6) :—

"(6) After any payment is made in accordance with this section no further claim in respect of such surplus shall be allowed against the Council at the instance of any person whomsoever. Provided that nothing herein contained shall affect the liability of any person who may receive the whole or part of any such surplus to pay the same to the person lawfully entitled thereto."

(f) The following is added as new sub-section (7) :—

"(7) In this section the expressions "*fidei commissary*" and "person entitled" shall mean the persons respectively who would have occupied such position in respect of the land or immovable property sold and conveyed, but for the title thereto vesting in the Council under the last preceding section."

3 Section 194 (1) of the principal Ordinance is amended by the substitution of the word "fifteen" for the word "ten" in line 12.

Amendment of section 194 (1) of the principal Ordinance.

#### *Objects and Reasons.*

1. Where a Municipal Council purchased any land or immovable property at a sale for non-payment of rates or taxes (section 144) and later sold the same (section 147) for a sum higher than what was really due to the Council in respect of such unpaid rates and taxes, the Council was till 1930 entitled to retain the entire sum realized at the second sale. The Municipal Councils Fourth Amendment Ordinance of that year, however, provided that any surplus that is left over after deducting what is due to the Council and the costs of recovery should, if demand is made within six years, be handed over to those who were entitled to the land or property at the time the Council purchased it. This Bill increases this period to ten years, and provides that in the case of minors and *fidei commissaries* the period does not begin to run until the attainment of majority and the accrual of the right of possession respectively. Provision is also introduced which protects a Council against successive demands for the surplus by persons claiming to have better rights to it than the person to whom the Council has made the payment.

2. The purpose of clause 3 is to extend, from 10 years to 15 years, the period over which a Municipality is permitted to spread the recovery of the expenses which it incurs in installing or improving the drainage system for any premises.

#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

#### **An Ordinance to amend the Joint Stock Companies Ordinances, 1861, 1888, and 1893.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Joint Stock Companies Amendment Ordinance, No.            of 193

Short title.

2 At the end of section 16 of the Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1893, the following proviso shall be added, namely :—

Amendment of section 16 of the Joint Stock

" Provided that it shall be lawful, and shall be deemed to have been at all times lawful, for the Registrar to accept, in mitigation of penalty, from any such party, parties or company, any sum smaller than the penalty incurred : and provided also that where the Registrar has at any time so accepted any sum, no suit shall be instituted or, if instituted, shall be maintained, for the recovery of the penalty so mitigated."

Companies Ordinance, 1893.

*Objects and Reasons.*

When a company incorporated abroad and establishing a place of business in Ceylon, fails to comply with any of the requirements of section 111 (1) of the Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1861, the Registrar has the power, under the proviso to section 111 (3) to accept from the company a sum of money in composition of the offence, instead of instituting a prosecution.

2. Although there is no corresponding provision as regards penalties incurred by local joint stock companies registered under section 14, it has been the practice since 1908, to waive legal proceedings and to accept mitigated penalties in cases of default made by them.

3. The purpose of this Bill is to introduce such provision and to give legal sanction to the practice followed for the last twenty-five years.
