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DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend the Societies Ordinance, 1891.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932.

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Ordinance.

- 2 Section 2 of The Societies Ordinance, 1891 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is amended by substituting the following for the definition of the term "Registrar" therein:—
 - "Registrar" means the Registrar-General and includes any officer in the Registrar-General's Department to the extent to which he may be authorized by general or special order of the Governor to discharge the duty of the Registrar under this Ordinance.

Amendment of section 6 of the principal Ordinance. 3 Section 6 (3) of the principal Ordinance is amended in line 7 by substituting for the words "in the Government Gazette" therein the words "in a newspaper published in the Island".

Amendment of section 8 of the principal Ordinance.

- ${\bf 4}$ Section 8 (1) of the principal Ordinance is amended as follows :—
 - (a) In paragraph (g) by substituting therefor the following:—
 - "(g) Keep a copy of the last balance sheet for the time being together with the report of the auditor always hung up in a conspicuous place at the registered office of the society."
 - (b) After paragraph (g) by adding the following new paragraph (h):—
 - "(h) Within a period of six months of its registration hold a general meeting of the members of the society and thereafter hold once at least in every calendar year a general meeting of its members."

Amendment of section 22 of the principal Ordinance.

- 5 Section 22 of the principal Ordinance is amended as follows:—
 - (a) Immediately after paragraph (d) thereof by adding as new paragraph (e) the following:—
 - "(e) If a registered society or branch of an officer or member thereof fails either to give any notice or to send any return, statement or document, or to do or allow to be done anything which the society, branch, officer or member is by this Ordinance required to give, send, do or allow to be done;"
 - (b) At the end of the section by adding as a new proviso the following:—
 - "Provided further that in respect of the offences described in paragraph (e) the Registrar may instead of instituting proceedings in a court of law, in composition of the offence committed accept from the society or branch or officer or member liable to punishment such sum of money not exceeding one hundred rupees as the Registrar may consider proper; and where composition is so accepted no other proceedings in respect of such offence shall be taken or continued against such society or branch or officer or member."

Insertion of new section 23 in the principal Ordinance

- ${f 6}$ After section 22 of the principal Ordinance the following is added as new section 23:—
- Persons liable for offences by society.
- "23. Where a registered society is guilty of an offence under this Ordinance every officer of the society bound by the rules thereof to fulfil any duty whereof the offence is a breach or if there is no such officer then every member of the committee unless that member is proved to have been ignorant of or to have attempted to prevent the commission of the offence shall be liable to the same penalty as if he had committed the offence."

Objects and Reasons.

The purpose of this Bill is to introduce certain amendments in The Societies Ordinance, 1891, which are designed to render the management of societies registered under the Ordinance less expensive and more efficient.

2. The publication in the Gazette of certain matters connected with such societies are made unnecessary by the amendments in clauses 3 and 4 (a) because such publication is expensive but does not in fact always reach those really concerned with the doings of the societies.

3. Clause 4 (b) by providing for a minimum number of meetings of the members of the society endeavours to give the members a more effective voice in the affairs of the society than they at present possess.

4. On pain of a fine or imprisonment clauses 5 and 6 provide for the proper performance of their duties by the officers and members of a society.

5. The new definition of "Registrar" in clause 1, which follows the definition of that term in recent legislation, is more convenient for working the Ordinance than the existing definition.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to repeal the enactments relating to the tax commonly known as the Poll Tax.

WHEREAS the annual tax payable in labour, or by commutation in money, commonly known as the Poll Tax, Road Tax, or Commutation Tax, has ceased to be levied in the Island after the year 1926:

And whereas the various enactments relating to the imposition and the levy of the said tax are no longer necessary but have not heretofore been expressly repealed.

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with
the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as
follows:—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Poll Tax Abolition Ordinance, 1932.

2 The several Ordinances enumerated in the first and second columns of the schedule hereto are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that schedule; and such repeals shall for all purposes be deemed to have been made on the 1st day of January, 1927.

3 Every Provincial Committee, and every District Committee, established under the provisions of the Road Ordinance, 1861, is hereby indemnified from and against any liability or other legal consequences whatsoever that may have arisen prior to the commencement of this Ordinance, by reason of any such Committee having failed to perform any duty or obligation cast on it by the Road Ordinance, 1861, and any rules made thereunder and by the Road Ordinance, 1861, Amendment Ordinance, 1884.

Objects and Reasons.

On November 21, 1924 a motion in the Legislative Council for the abolition of the Poll Tax was accepted by the Government, and by a resolution of the Executive Council dated June 22, 1926, it was decided that a subsidy should be given to local bodies out of the public funds to take the place of the revenue they derived from the Poll Tax and therefore by implication that the tax should no longer be levied in the Island. But the relevant sections of the various Ordinances that authorize the collection of the tax were not formally repealed at the time. The object of the present draft Ordinance is to effect a formal repeal of all the provisions, now no longer necessary, that direct or enable the various local authorities

to levy the tax.

2. The acts of omission or non-compliance on the part of the District Road Committees during the intervening period may on a strict interpretation be regarded as unlawful. repeal is therefore referred back in clause 2 to the date of the decision arrived at by the Government, and in addition an indemnifying clause is provided in clause 3.
