- (1) The permit will be issued for five years.
- (2) The permit-holder shall commence within the first year to cultivate and assedumize the paddy land and to cultivate and improve the high land and he shall, to the satisfaction of the Assistant Government Agent, proceed with the work each year and complete the same by the end of the fifth year. He shall thereafter cultivate annually at least three quarters of the land.
- (3) The permit-holder shall pay in advance an annual rent of 50 cents per acre per annum.
- (4) The permit-holder shall after the third year of his occupation be liable to pay such irrigation rates on irrigable land as may be determined by Government. The initial payment shall not exceed Rs. 2 per acre per annum.
- (5) The permit-holder shall be subject to all irrigation and cultivation rules existing at present or which may lawfully be made hereafter.
- (6) The permit-holder will be entitled to make use of the timber on the land for fencing, or for the erection of watch huts or houses on the land. He shall, however, have no right to remove any timber whatsoever from the land without permission which may be granted upon such terms as to payment or otherwise as may be decided.
- (7) The permit-holder shall build a house to the satisfaction of the Assistant Government Agent on the land allotted to him and reside therein.
- (8) The permit-holder shall not, without the permission of the Assistant Government Agent, alienate, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of his interests under this permit in any way whatsoever and any such alienation, mortgage, or disposition shall be null and void.
- (9) Should the permit-holder contravene or fail to carry out any of the conditions of the permit or should the said land or interest of the permit-holder be seized or sold in execution of a decree against the permit-holder, the Assistant Government Agent may cancel the permit and take possession of the land and any crops, plantations, buildings, or other improvements upon it and neither the permit-holder nor any person claiming through him shall have any right to claim any compensation whatsoever for any improvement effected by the permit-holder or any other person upon the land.
- (10) The permit-holder shall surrender free of compensation any portion of the land allotted to him which may be required hereafter by Government for roads, channels, or any other purpose.
- (11) The permit-holder may nominate a person to whom he desires that the Assistant Government Agent should issue a fresh permit in the event of the death of the permit-holder during the term of the permit.
- (12) The permit shall be personal to the permit-holder and shall terminate with his death.
- (13) On the termination of the permit in any other way than by the coming into effect of the Ordinance referred to above, the land shall revert to the Crown and no person shall have any right to claim compensation from the Crown for any improvements upon it.
- (14) In the event of the termination of the permit by the death of the permit-holder the Assistant Government Agent may at his discretion issue a fresh permit for the land to the person nominated by the late permit-holder, if he considers him a fit person, or to any dependent of the late permit-holder or to any other person.
