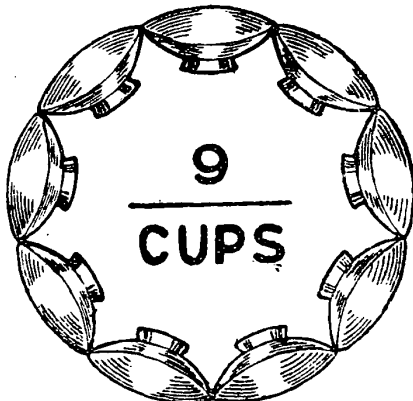

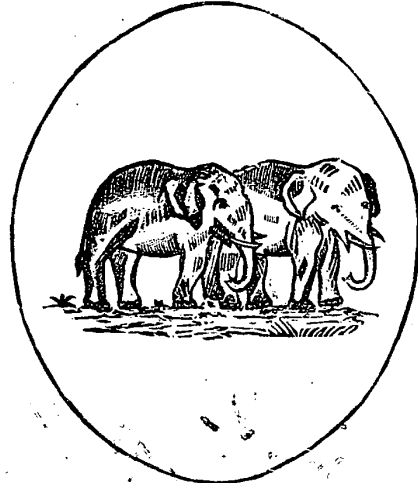

## VITAL STATISTICS.

Registrar-General's Report on Vital Statistics of the City of Colombo for the Week ended April 29, 1933.

*Births.*—The total births registered in the city of Colombo in the week were 206 (1 European, 10 Burghers, 129 Sinhalese, 29 Tamils, 31 Moors, 5 Malays, and 1 Other). The birth rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on January 1, 1933, viz., 292,200) was 36·8, as against 34·8 in the preceding week, 28·5 in the corresponding week of last year, and 30·3 the weekly average for last year.

*Deaths.*—The total deaths registered were 129 (7 Burghers, 79 Sinhalese, 19 Tamils, 18 Moors, 3 Malays, and 3 Others). The death rate per 1,000 per annum was 23·0, as against 29·1 in the previous week, 20·8 in the corresponding week of last year, and 24·5 the weekly average for last year.

*Infantile Deaths.*—Of the 129 total deaths, 21 were of infants under one year of age, as against 31 in the preceding week, 25 in the corresponding week of the previous year, and 29 the average for last year.

*Stillbirths.*—The number of stillbirths registered during the week was 19.

*Principal Causes of Death.*—1. (a) Eighteen deaths from *Pneumonia* were registered, 11 in Maradana hospitals (including 5 deaths of non-residents), 4 in Kotahena South, and 1 each in Maradana South, Kollupitiya, and Wellawatta South, as against 16 in the previous week and 15 the weekly average for last year.

(b) Ten deaths from *Influenza* were registered, 3 each in San Sebastian and New Bazaar, 2 in Slave Island, and 1 each in St. Paul's and Wellawatta North, as against 9 in the previous week, and 8 the weekly average for last year.

(c) Three deaths from *Bronchitis* were registered, 2 in Maradana hospitals (including 1 death of a non-resident) and 1 in Maradana South, as against 4 in the previous week, and 3 the weekly average for last year.

2. (a) Twelve deaths from *Phthisis* were registered, 7 in Maradana hospitals (including 4 deaths of non-residents), 2 in San Sebastian, and 1 each in Kotahena North, Maradana North, and Slave Island, as against 18 in the previous week, and 11 the weekly average for last year.

(b) Three deaths from *Phthisis*, of residents of Colombo town, occurred at the Anti-Tuberculosis Hospital, Ragama, during the week.

3. Four deaths from *Enteric Fever* were registered, 3 in Maradana hospitals (including 1 death of a non-resident) and 1 in Kollupitiya. The number registered during the preceding week was also 4 and the weekly average for last year was 3.

4. Seven deaths from *Debility* were registered, 5 from *Worms*, 4 from *Accidents*, 3 from *Enteritis*, 2 each from *Dysentery*, *Infantile Convulsions*, and *Puerperal Septicaemia*, 1 from *Diarrhoea*, and 56 from *Other Causes*.

5. *Reported Cases.*—Thirty-three cases of *Measles*, 30 of *Chickenpox*, 5 of *Enteric Fever*, 4 of *Whooping Cough*, 2 of *Diphtheria*, and 1 of *Mumps* were reported during the week, as against 27, 19, 5, 5, 1, and 2, respectively, of the preceding week.

*State of the Weather.*—The mean temperature of air was 82·8°, against 82·3° in the preceding week and 81·8° in the corresponding week of the previous year. The mean atmospheric pressure was 29·903 in., against 29·875 in. in the preceding week and 29·884 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was 0·21 in., against 0·22 in. in the preceding week, and 0·29 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year.
