PASSED ORDINANCE.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 9 of 1932.

An Ordinance to amend "The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924".

GRAEME THOMSON.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Village Communities (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 9 of 1932.

Repeal of section 16 of the principal Ordinance and substitution of a new section therefor.

2 Section 16 of "The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924", (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance), is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:

16 (1) The Government Agent shall, as soon as possible after the election of a committee, convene the first meeting thereof by notices in writing addressed to and served upon each elected member of such committee. Service shall either be effected personally or, if that be not possible, by the notice being left at the member's last known place of abode: Provided that the notice shall be served not less than five days before the date of the meeting.

(2) Each such notice shall prescribe the date, time and place of the meeting and the date prescribed shall be within the period of twenty-one days next succeeding the date hereinafter appointed for the commencement of the term of office of the committee.

(3) Every such meeting shall be held at the time and place and on the date prescribed and shall be presided over by the Government Agent.

(4) At such meeting the members of the committee shall elect one of their own number to be the chairman of such committee.

(5) The election of a chairman shall be by a majority of the votes of the members of the committee present and voting but no election of a chairman shall be held unless there is present a quorum consisting of not less than half the number of the elected members of the committee.

(6) If there is no quorum present, it shall be lawful for the Government Agent, once or oftener, to adjourn the meeting and to convene it for another date or time or place in the manner prescribed in sub-sections (1) and (2) of this section, but so that the adjourned date shall similarly be within the period of twenty-one days referred to in sub-section (2) of this section.

(7) The voting at any meeting held in accordance with the provisions of this section shall be by secret ballot. Any matter of procedure arising at any such meeting and not herein provided for shall be decided by the Government Agent whose decision thereon shall be final and conclusive.

The Government Agent shall have no vote. In the event of an equality of votes the decision as between the candidates whose votes are equal shall be determined by lot in such manner as the Government Agent may decide.

(8) If a chairman has not been elected

(a) at any meeting convened and constituted as hereinbefore in this section provided, or,

(b) within the period of twenty-one days prescribed in sub-section (2) of this section, or,

(c) in a committee elected prior to the enactment of this Ordinance

it shall be lawful for the Governor to nominate one of the elected members of the committee to be the chairman thereof and the member so nominated shall for all purposes be deemed to be the elected chairman of such committee.

(9) An elected or nominated chairman shall hold office during the term of the committee, unless he shall meanwhile, for any cause, have ceased to be a member thereof. In the event of there being a vacancy in the Office of Chairman the Government Agent shall within one month of his becoming aware of such vacancy take steps in the manner indicated above for the election of a new Chairman.

3 Section 18 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following sub-section :

(f) if he is a Chief or minor Headman other than a Vel-Vidane.

4 The following section shall be inserted immediately after section 29 of the principal Ordinance and shall have effect as section 29A thereof :

29A No rules already made or hereafter to be made under the provisions of section 29 (33) of this Ordinance, prescribing the number to form a quorum at meetings of the committee and the manner of conducting business at such meetings, shall have any application to any meeting convened or held under the provisions of section 16 of this Ordinance.

DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance regulating the Temporal Affairs of the Presbyterian Church in Kandy.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Temporal Affairs of the Presbyterian Church Kandy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932.

2 Section 3 of the Ordinance regulating the Temporal Affairs of the Presbyterian Church in Kandy is amended by the substitution of the word "Sunday" for the word "Monday" therein contained.

3 Sections 3 and 11 of the said Ordinance are amended by the substitution of the word "first" for the word "last" therein contained.

4 Section 14 of the said Ordinance is amended by the deletion of the words "a male of" in line 12 thereof.

Objects and Reasons.

The purpose of this bill is to alter the date of the Annual General Meeting of seat-holders from the last Monday in December as the majority of seat-holders are not in Kandy at that time ; and to give all seat-holders, irrespective of their sex, the right to vote.
