The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to make Supplementary Provision for the Public and Colombo Electricity Supply Services for the Financial Year 1930-31.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1930–31) Ordinance, No. of 1932.

Short title.

2 In addition to the sum appropriated by the Appropriation Ordinance of 1930, the several sums appearing in Schedule I hereto and amounting in the aggregate to the sum of seventy-two thousand eight hundred and twenty-three rupees and eighty-three cents are hereby declared payable out of the revenue of this Island for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1930, and ending on September 30, 1931, in respect of the several services mentioned in the said Schedule.

Appropriation of Rs. 72,823 · 83 from revenue of the Island for financial year ending September 30, 1931.

3 In addition to the sum appropriated by the Appropriation Ordinance of 1930, the several sums appearing in Schedule II hereto and amounting in the aggregate to the sum of thirty-three thousand five hundred and twelve rupees and one cent are hereby declared payable out of the revenue of the Colombo Electricity Supply for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1930, and ending on September 30, 1931, in respect of the several services mentioned in the said Schedule.
