## DRAFT ORDINANCE.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

## An Ordinance to amend the Medical Ordinance, 1927.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Medical Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1932.

Amendment of section 65 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 65 of the Medical Ordinance, 1927, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "shall be paid into general revenue, and" in the first and second lines thereof.

Repeal of section 68 of the principal Ordinance and substitution of a new section therefor.

3 Section 68 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor :

68 For the purpose of defraying such expenses as may be incurred in the exercise of its powers and in the performance of its duties under this Ordinance, the Medical Council shall be entitled to receive—

- (1) all fees payable under Chapters V, VI, VII, VIII, and IX of this Ordinance ;
- (2) a sum of one thousand rupees annually from general revenue.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

1. The object of this Ordinance is to repeal those provisions of the principal Ordinance under which moneys recovered as fees had to be credited to general revenue. Such fees will hereafter be credited to the funds of the Medical Council for the purpose of defraying such expenses as may be incurred by the Council in the discharge of its duties under the Ordinance.

2. These amendments do not affect sections 9 and 13 of the principal Ordinance. The Ceylon Medical College will continue to be maintained out of the funds provided for the purpose by the State Council and the fees prescribed by the College Council will continue to be paid into general revenue.
