Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 6 of 1933.**An Ordinance to amend The Chanks Ordinance, 1890.**

GRAEME THOMSON.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Chanks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933.

Insertion of section 7 in the principal Ordinance. 2 The Chanks Ordinance 1890 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is amended by the insertion of the following section 7 :—

Power to declare a chank fishery camp.

7 (1) The Governor may, with the advice of the Minister for Health, from time to time by notification in the Government Gazette declare any place to be a chank fishery camp for the purpose of chank fishery, and prescribe the period of such fishery and may appoint any person to be camp superintendent thereof. A notification under this section may be amended from time to time.

(2) A place declared to be a chank fishery camp shall be deemed to be a chank fishery camp within the meaning of this Ordinance for one month before the commencement of, during the continuance of, and for one month after the termination of the fishery for which the camp is established.

Insertion of new section 7A in the principal Ordinance. 3 The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the following new section 7A between section 7 and section 8 :—

Regulations and penalty.

7A (1) The Executive Committee of Health may make regulations in respect of any chank fishery for preserving order, for preventing accidents, fire and disease, for regulating water supply, sanitation, and for any other matter or thing similar to those hereinbefore enumerated which the said Committee considers necessary or convenient for the proper administration of a chank fishery camp. Any person who contravenes or attempts to contravene or abets the contravention of any regulation made under this section shall be guilty of an offence and, on conviction by a police magistrate, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees.

(2) Notwithstanding section 9 (2) no regulation made under this section shall have effect unless it has been approved by the State Council and ratified by the Governor. Notification of such approval and ratification shall be published in the Government Gazette and no regulation shall come into operation until the date of the publication of such notification.

An Ordinance to amend the Police Ordinance, 1865.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Police Amendment Ordinance, 1933. Short title.

2 Section 34 of the Police Ordinance, 1865, is amended by the insertion of the following new proviso between the second and the third proviso thereof :— Amendment of section 34 of Ordinance No. 16 of 1865.

“ Provided that it shall be lawful and shall be deemed to have been at all times lawful to refrain in respect of any town from appointing any such percentage on the annual value.”

Objects and Reasons.

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize the exemption of towns from the payment of the tax levied under section 34 of the Police Ordinance, 1865, and to legalize such exemptions already made.
