KNOW Ye that by virtue of the powers vested in Us by Article 93 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, We, the Governor, do hereby proclaim the rule set out in the schedule hereto, framed and established by Us for the Port of Colombo under section 6 of the Masters Attendant's Ordinance, 1865, and direct that it shall be in force from and after the First day of July, 1932.

SCHEDULE.

1. Rule 1 in section V. of the rules dated August 6, 1930, and published in *Gazette* No. 7,797 of August 8, 1930, is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:—

Rates of Pilotage.

Section V., Rule 1.—All vessels other than those exempted by rule 2 below, or by special permission given under that rule, from having a pilot on board while entering, leaving, or moving within the harbour, shall pay pilotage at the following rates which shall cover them both inwards and outwards:—

and so on, adding an extra charge of Rs. 6.25 for every additional 500 tons or portion thereof.

The above rate will also be charged when a vessel is moved from one berth to another, or from one berth to another and back from the latter berth to her original or another berth. Provided that no extra charge shall be made for vessels moved to and from the Oil Bunkering Jetties or Graving Dock Guide Pier for the receipt of oil, or to and from the Graving Dock Guide Pier or Oil Discharge Jetty for the discharge of oil.

A further charge of half the above sanctioned rates will be levied in respect of any vessel seeking to proceed out of the harbour or to change her berth which calls a pilot before she is ready to proceed and thereby causes any delay whatever to the pilot.

The certificate for this charge is to be signed and handed to the pilot by the master of the vessel before the vessel leaves her berth.

Provided that—

Vessels which, while in harbour, carry out none but the following operations :—

- (a) Coaling ;
- (b) Taking in water ;
- (c) Taking in provisions ;
- (d) Awaiting or receiving orders ;
- (e) Taking in or discharging mails ;
- (f) Discharging sick persons, their attendants and families ;
- (g) Discharging or taking in crews ;
- (h) Going into Dock ;
- (i) Repairs ; and
- (j) Discharging or shipping overcarried cargo shall be charged a special consolidated rate of Rs. 200 only to cover pilotage, entering dues, use of tugs, and bill of health granted by day.
