THIS matter coming on for disposal before R. F. Dias, Esq., District Judge of Chilaw, on May 13, 1932, in the presence of Messrs. Corea & Corea, Proctors, on the part of the petitioner above named; and the affidavit of the said petitioner dated December 17, 1932, having been read:

It is ordered that the 1st respondent be and he is hereby appointed guardian *ad litem* over the 4th respondent, who is a minor, for the purpose of these proceedings, and that the petitioner be and he is hereby declared entitled, as the widow of the said deceased, to have letters of administration to his estate issued to her, unless the respondents above named or any other person or persons interested shall, on or before August 26, 1932, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
