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PASSED ORDINANCE.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 21 of 1932.

An Ordinance to amend the Income Tax Ordinance, 1932.

GRAEME THOMSON.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Income Tax Amendment Ordinance, No. 21 of 1932.

Amendment of section 7 (1) of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 7 (1) of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1932, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is hereby amended by the substitution of a comma for the colon immediately after the figures "1921" in the third line of paragraph (n) thereof and by the addition of the following words at the end of the said paragraph:

"provided that the majority of the members of any such society are resident in Ceylon and provided that in a case where a co-operative society is a member of another co-operative society so registered, each of the members of the former society shall be deemed individually to be and shall be reckoned as a member of the latter society for the purpose of ascertaining whether a majority of the members of the latter society are resident in Ceylon:"

Amendment of section 20 of the principal Ordinance.

- 3 Section 20 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of sub-section (2) thereof and by the substitution of the following sub-section therefor:
 - "(2) Where for any year of assessment no tax is chargeable under sub-section (1) in respect of the income of an individual resident in Ceylon, or where for any year of assessment the tax chargeable under that sub-section upon the taxable income of an individual resident in Ceylon amounts to less than one per cent of his assessable income, tax shall be charged for such year of assessment in respect of the income of either such individual at the rate of one per cent. upon his assessable income for that year: provided that tax charged under this sub-section shall be in lieu of and not in addition to the tax, if any, chargeable under sub-section (1)".

Amendment of section 27 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 27 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the word "executor" for the word "execution" in the seventh line thereof.

Amendment of section 30 (4) of the principal Ordinance.

- 5 Section 30 (4) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended—-
 - (1) by the insertion of the following words between the word "excess" and the word "not" in the sixth line thereof:
 - "or the total amount of such excesses where expenditure has been so incurred by any such person on more immature areas than one,";
 - (2) By the insertion of the words "in any case" between the word "exceeding" and the word "fifteen" in the sixth line thereof; and

(3) by the insertion of a comma between the word "period" and the word "shall" in the eighth line thereof.

6 The provisions of this Ordinance shall have effect as from the 9th day of February, 1932, notwithstanding anything in any written law to the contrary.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance for making provision for the Public, Railway and Colombo Electricity Supply services for the financial year 1932–33.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

- 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, No. of 1932.
- 2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding seventy-seven million eight hundred and five-thousand four hundred and thirty-three rupees, twenty-two million rupees, and two million one hundred and thirty thousand rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1932, and ending on September 30, 1933, out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the schedules to this Ordinance.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Excise Ordinance, No. 8 of 1912."

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Excise Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1932.

2 Section 17 of "The Excise Ordinance, No. 8 of 1912," (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is hereby amended by the deletion of the full-stop immediat ly after the word "Ordinance" in the fourth line of paragraph (1) of the proviso thereof and by the addition of the following words immediately after the said word "Ordinance:"

" or to a person licensed under this Ordinance to manufacture arrack or vinegar from toddy."

Short title.

Amendment of section 17 of Ordinance No. 8 of 1912.

Amendment of

section 34 of

the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 34 o the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) by the re-numbering of the said section as section "34 (1)";

(2) by the deletion of the full-stop immediately after the words "to be" in the thirteenth line thereof and by the addition of the following words immediately after the said words:

" and, for the purposes of such search, may stop any such person, vessel, vehicle or animal.";

- (3) by the addition of the following as sub-section (2) thereof:
- "(_) The driver of any vehicle or vessel who fails or refuses to stop or to halt such vehicle or vessel wh n directed to do so either verbally or by signal by an Excise Officer n t bel w the rank of Inspector wearing his uniform and acting in execution of his duty, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding fifty rupees or in default of payment of such fine to simple imprisonment for a term which may extend to six weeks."
- (4) by the addition of the following as sub-section (3) thereof:
- "(3) In this section "ve icle" includes any carriage coach, cart, motor-car, motor-cycle, omnibus, lorry, bicycle, or other mechanically propelled vehicle and the "driver" of a vehicle includes the rider of a motor-cycle or of a bicycle; and "signal" includes one or more blasts of a whistle."

Objects and Reasons.

- 1. Clause 2.—The object of this amendment of section 17 of the principal Ordinance is to enable a person having the right to the toddy drawn from a tree to sell such toddy without a licence to licensed manufacturers of arrack or vinegar.
- 2. Clause 3.—The object of this amendment of section 34 f the principal Ordinance is to confer explicitly on Excise Officers not below the rank of Inspector the right to stop or to detain, for the purposes of search, persons, vessels, vehicles or animals whi h they are now entitled to search by virtue of the powers already taken by that section.

Provision has also been made penalising those who refuse to stop when directed to do so either verbally or by signal. It has also been found necessary to define the terms "vehicle," "driver" and "signal" for the purposes of the section.
