PASSED ORDINANCE.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 26 of 1932.

An Ordinance for making provision for the Public, Railway and Colombo Electricity Supply services for the financial year 1932-33.

GRAEME THOMSON.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, No. 26 of 1932.

Appropriation for the year 1932-33.

2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding seventy-five million nine hundred and forty-eight thousand six hundred and twelve rupees, twenty-two million rupees, and two million one hundred and thirty thousand rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1932, and ending on September 30, 1933, out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the schedules to this Ordinance.
