Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

**No. 27 of 1932.****An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908".**

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

**1** This Ordinance may be cited as the Post Office Amendment Ordinance, No. 27 of 1932.

Amendment of section 83 (6) of the principal Ordinance.

**2** Sub-section (6) of section 83 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of a comma for the full stop immediately after the word "country" in the sixth line thereof and by the addition of the following words immediately thereafter:—

"and includes any such facsimile or imitation or representation of an international reply coupon or of an imperial reply coupon."

It is further declared that the said Millicent Eva Tennekoon is the executrix named in the said will, and that she is entitled to have probate of the same issued to her accordingly, unless the respondents or any other person shall, on or before December 16, 1932, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
