**An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

- Short title. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, No. 38 of 1933.
- Amendment of section 131 of principal Ordinance. 2 Section 131 (2) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, is amended by substituting the words "one thousand five hundred" for the words "five hundred" occurring at the end.
