An Ordinance to amend the Gas Ordinance, 1869.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Gas (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1934.

Amendment of section 4A of the principal Ordinance. 2 Section 4A of the Gas Ordinance, 1869, is amended by the addition of the following new sub-section (3) at the end :—

“(3) Notwithstanding the failure to provide under the preceding sub-sections the requisite authorizations and declarations in respect of (a) the area under the Sanitary Board of Colombo District which was within the limits of the town of Dehiwala-Mount Lavinia and (b) the area now within the jurisdiction of the Urban District Council of Dehiwala-Mount Lavinia, all matters and things which such Sanitary Board or such Urban District Council or the Chairman of such Board or Council or the Colombo Gas and Water Company Limited has heretofore done or omitted to do within such areas shall, to the extent to which such acts or omissions might have been previously authorized or declared under the said sub-sections, be deemed for all purposes and in all respects to have been lawfully done or omitted as the case may be.

Objects and Reasons.

Under the Gas Ordinance, 1869, it was possible to confer only on municipal towns the powers necessary for the supply of gas. The Gas Ordinance, No. 15 of 1926, made it possible by proclamation to extend such powers to areas outside municipal towns and to enable certain other local authorities also to enter into the contracts necessary for the supply of gas within their respective jurisdictions. In 1929 accordingly, the Urban District Council of Dehiwala-Mount Lavinia entered into a contract with the Colombo Gas and Water Company Limited in supposed pursuance of its powers under the Ordinance of 1926. It is now clear, however, that there is no legal authority for this contract and for everything done in consequence of it, because no proclamation has been published providing in the manner contemplated by the 1926 Ordinance the necessary authorizations and declarations in respect of the area within that Urban District Council's jurisdiction.

2. The purpose of this Bill is to validate all things done or omitted in supposed pursuance of such a proclamation, provided they would have been lawful if a proclamation had been published in time.

An Ordinance to amend the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Tea (Control of Export) Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1934.

Amendment of section 31 (1) of Ordinance No. 11 of 1933. 2 Sub-section (1) of section thirty-one of the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso at the end thereof :—

“Provided, however, that no made tea shall be so exported on any stock export licence after a date to be declared by the Governor by proclamation in the Gazette.”

Objects and Reasons.

By a Proclamation made under section 28 of the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, and published in Government Gazette No. 8,003 of September 8, 1933, the 2nd October 1933, was declared by the Governor to be the date on and after which no made tea shall be exported from the Island unless the exportation thereof is authorised by an export licence or a stock export licence.

2. Export licences are issued in respect of producers' own tea in hand before the 2nd October, 1933, and manufactured on or after that date. Stock export licences are issued in respect of tea made from bought-leaf and in hand on the eve of the declared date and in respect of dealers' stocks in hand on the eve of the same date.

3. No time limit was fixed by the principal Ordinance or can be fixed under it for the export of made tea on stock export licences. The object of this Bill is to authorise the Governor to fix a date after which made tea cannot be exported on a stock export licence and so to compel the clearance of made tea which was in hand on the eve of the declared date.

An Ordinance to amend The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1934.

Short title:

2 Sub-section (2) of section forty of "The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910," (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is hereby repealed and the following sub-section is substituted therefor :—

Repeal of section 40 (2) of Ordinance No. 6 of 1910 and substitution of a new sub-section therefor.

(2) Such lists shall be prepared before the thirty-first day of August in every year or as soon thereafter as shall be possible, and notice of such preparation shall forthwith be given in two or more of the local newspapers. The said lists shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times of the day in the Municipal Office or at any other place specified in such notice.

3 Sub-section (3) of section forty-one of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso at the end thereof :—

Amendment of section 41 (3) of the principal Ordinance.

" Provided, however, that for the purposes of this section, sub-section (3) of section fifteen shall be construed as if the word 'preparation' were substituted for the word 'publication' occurring therein."

4 Section eighty-three of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "and shall be published in the Government Gazette" at the end thereof.

Amendment of section 83 of the principal Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

Section 40 (2) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910 provides that new and revised lists of voters and electors shall when prepared, be published in the Government Gazette. Clause 2 of this Bill dispenses with the necessity for such publication which involves considerable expense and serves no purpose which cannot equally well be served by local publication. Clause 3 effects a consequential amendment in section 41.

2. Clause 4 of the Bill amends section 83 of the Ordinance and repeals the provision of law which requires statements of receipts and disbursements and minutes of meetings to be published in the Government Gazette.
