DRAFT ORDINANCES.**MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance relating to the appointment of
Curators for the purpose of grants and
leases of Crown land.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

- Short title. **1** This Ordinance may be cited as the Crown Grants (Curatorship of Minors) Ordinance, No. of 1934.
- Interpretation. **2** In this Ordinance unless the context otherwise requires "Settlement Officer" means the Settlement Officer and any Assistant Settlement Officer appointed under the Land Settlement Ordinance, 1931, and includes the Government Agent or the Assistant Government Agent in respect of land situated within his province or district respectively.
- Purpose for which curator may be appointed. **3** Notwithstanding the provisions of any other written law, the Settlement Officer may, for the purpose of a grant or lease in favour of a minor of any land or interest in land belonging to the Crown, appoint after such inquiry as he considers necessary, any fit and proper person as the curator of the property of such minor.
- Manner of appointment. **4** The Settlement Officer shall make a record in writing of the proceedings of any inquiry under section 3, and where an appointment is made under the said section he shall forward to the District Judge within the local limits of whose jurisdiction such minor resides a certificate in duplicate signed by him containing the following particulars, namely :—
(a) the date on which the appointment is made ;
(b) the purpose of making the appointment ;
(c) the name and address of the minor ;
(d) the name and address of the person appointed curator ;
(e) the nature and details of the transaction.
- Confirmation of appointment by District Judge. **5** The District Judge on receiving any such certificate shall endorse an order thereon either (a) confirming such appointment or (b) setting aside the appointment and appointing some other person curator. Provided that as a preliminary to making any such order it shall not be necessary for the District Judge to require the Settlement Officer or the curator or the minor or any other person to appear before him.
- Record of appointment. **6** One copy of the certificate so endorsed shall be retained by the District Judge and filed in his court, while the other shall be filed in the record of proceedings under section 4 relating to it.
- Effect of appointment. **7** An appointment confirmed under section 5 shall be deemed to be valid as from the date on which it was first made by the Settlement Officer, and it shall for the purposes of the grant or lease in respect of which the appointment was made be as valid and effectual from the said date as if it had then been made in accordance with the provisions of Chapter XL of the Civil Procedure Code, 1889.
- Appointment not liable to stamp duty. **8** No stamp duty shall be payable in respect of any appointment made under this Ordinance, anything in the Stamp Ordinance 1909 to the contrary notwithstanding.

Objects and Reasons.

When a grant or lease of Crown land is to be made to a minor, a curator has now to be first appointed in the manner provided in the Civil Procedure Code, 1889, so that he might on behalf of the minor legally undertake to perform the covenants and other duties attached to the grant or lease. The process of having a curator appointed under the Civil Procedure Code is liable to some delay, and is generally expensive especially where the minor resides in some remote locality.

2. This Bill therefore provides on the lines of section 25 of the Land Settlement Ordinance 1931, an expeditious and inexpensive way of getting a curator appointed for the special purpose of such a grant or lease.

An Ordinance to amend The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1934. Short title.

2 Sub-section (2) of section forty of "The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910," (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is hereby repealed and the following sub-section is substituted therefor :— Repeal of section 40 (2) of Ordinance No. 6 of 1910 and substitution of a new sub-section therefor.

(2) Such lists shall be prepared before the thirty-first day of August in every year or as soon thereafter as shall be possible, and notice of such preparation shall forthwith be given in two or more of the local newspapers. The said lists shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times of the day in the Municipal Office or at any other place specified in such notice.

3 Sub-section (3) of section forty-one of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso at the end thereof :— Amendment of section 41 (3) of the principal Ordinance.

" Provided, however, that for the purposes of this section, sub-section (3) of section fifteen shall be construed as if the word 'preparation' were substituted for the word 'publication' occurring therein."

4 Section eighty-three of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "and shall be published in the Government Gazette" at the end thereof. Amendment of section 83 of the principal Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

Section 40 (2) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, provides that new and revised lists of voters and electors shall, when prepared, be published in the Government Gazette. Clause 2 of this Bill dispenses with the necessity for such publication which involves considerable expense and serves no purpose which cannot equally well be served by local publication. Clause 3 effects a consequential amendment in section 41.

2. Clause 4 of the Bill amends section 83 of the Ordinance and repeals the provision of law which requires statements of receipts and disbursements and minutes of meetings to be published in the Government Gazette.
