Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 4 of 1934.

613/1 (S.B.)

An Ordinance to amend the Stamp Ordinance, 1909.

R. E. STITERS.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Amendment Ordinance, No. 4 of 1934.

Amendment of Part I of Schedule B of the principal Ordinance. 2 Part I of Schedule B of the Stamp Ordinance, 1909, is amended by the insertion of the following new item 51E between item 51D and item 52:—

51E Transfer or assignment of any stock or marketable security—

Where the purchase or consideration money therein or thereupon expressed, or, if the consideration be other than a pecuniary one, or partly pecuniary and partly other than pecuniary, the value of the stock or security, shall be—

Provided that where in any case the Commissioner of Stamps is of the opinion that the purchase or consideration money therein or thereupon expressed is less than the value of such stock or marketable security, he may by endorsement on the instrument of transfer or assignment require it to be stamped upon the value of the stock or marketable security and an instrument so endorsed shall be deemed to be not duly stamped unless and until it is stamped as required by the Commissioner of Stamps.
