If neither the applicant nor any person authorized in writing to represent him attends the Land Kacheheri, the Assistant Government Agent, Hambantota, may presume that the applicant does not wish to pursue his application further.

3. 5. If the land has not yet been surveyed into suitable blocks the final disposal of the land may be postponed pending survey.

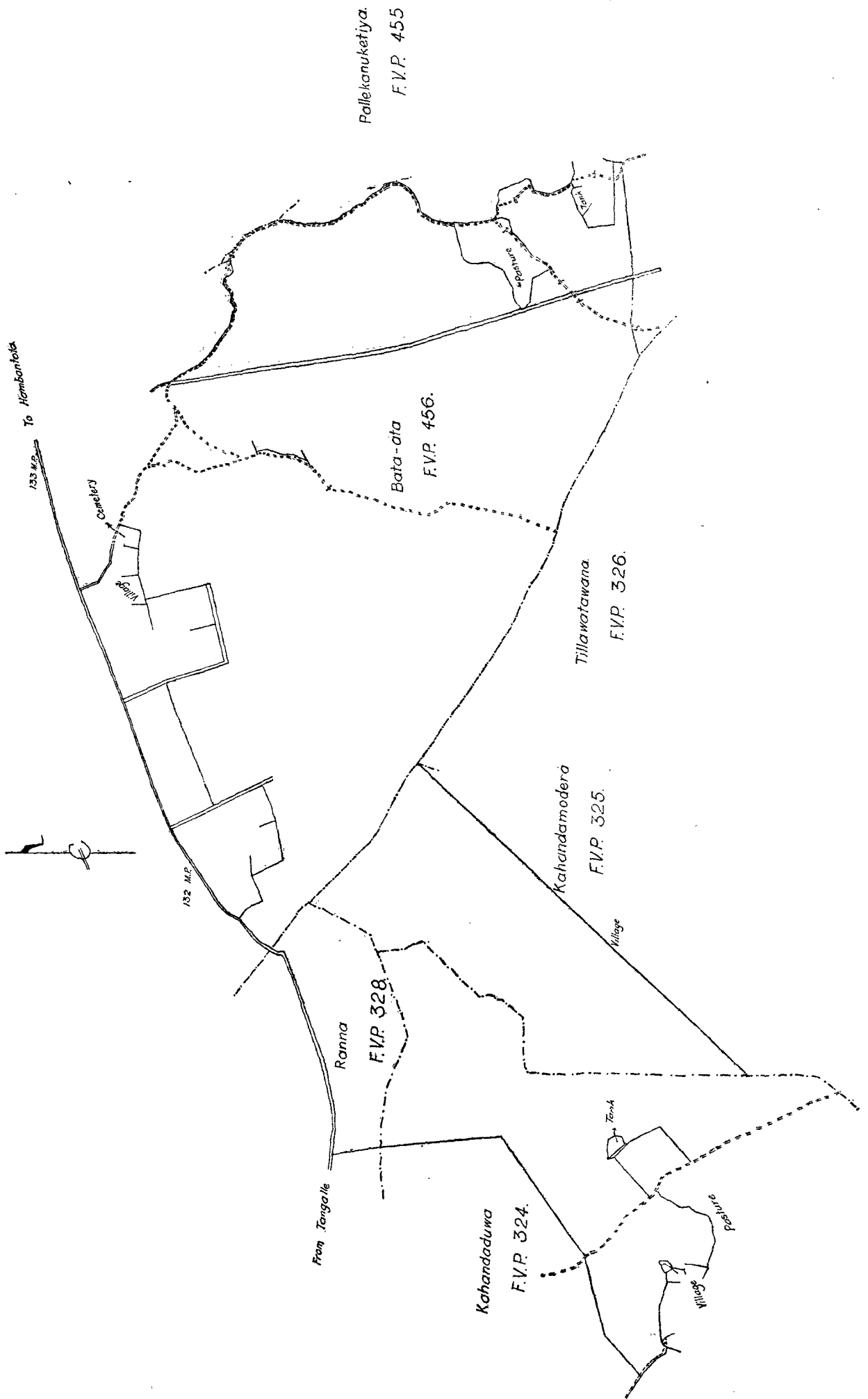
