THE CEYLON (STATE COUNCIL ELECTIONS) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1931.

IT is hereby notified for general information that by virtue of the powers vested in him by Article 23 (4) of the Ceylon (State Council Elections) Order in Council, 1931, as amended by the Ceylon (State Council Elections) Amendment Order in Council, 1934, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order an election to be held, and to specify the 1st day of June, 1934, as the date when candidates are to be nominated and the Jaffna Kachcheri as the place of nomination, for the election of members of the State Council for the electoral districts of Kayts, Kankasanturai, Jaffna, and Point Pedro, in which, owing to the failure to nominate any candidate for election no election was held in pursuance of the order made by Proclamation in the *Gazette Extraordinary* of April 18, 1931.
