THE CEYLON (STATE COUNCIL) AMENDMENT ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1934. THE following Order of His Majesty in Council is published for general information.

WHEREAS by the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, provision was madmance No. 1 citation. Council in and for the Island of Ceylon:

2. Clause (3) of Article 34 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council' new Clause substituted therefor :---

(3) Subject to the provisions of this Article procedure for the ele assignment to an Executive Committee of any member elected to the Co a general election and for the transfer of members from one Committee to Orders of the Council.

3. Article 88 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, shall be read and construed as though instead of sub-heads (a) and (b) of Clause (1) thereof the following sub-heads had been inserted therein and had been in force as from the date of the coming into operation of the said Order :—

(a) persons who, at any time prior to the seventeenth day of July, 1928, were appointed to any public office with or subject to the general or special approval of the Secretary of State or who, prior to the date aforesaid, were selected for appointment to any public office by the Secretary of State or had entered into agreement with the Crown Agents for the Colonies to serve in any public office for a term of years;
(b) persons who, at any time after the sixteenth day of July, 1928, and prior to the twelfth day of December, using a secretary or blick of the secretary of years;
(b) persons who, at any time after the sixteenth day of July, 1928, and prior to the twelfth day of December, the secretary of the secretary of

1929, were appointed or selected for appointment to any public office with or subject to such approval or by such authority, or had entered into such agreement, as is mentioned in the sub-head (a) immediately preceding.

4. His Majesty hereby reserves to Himself, His Heirs and Successors, power, with the advice of His or Their Privy Council, to revoke, alter, or amend this Order as to Him or Them shall seem fit.

5. This Order shall be published in the Ceylon Government Gazette and shall thereupon come into operation.
