No. 8 of 1934.

An Ordinance to amend the Tea Cess (Temporary Increase) Ordinance, No. 12 of 1930.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.	1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Tea Cess (Temporary Increase) Amendment Ordinance, No. 8 of 1934.
Duration of Ordinance No. 12 of 1930, extended to 31st December, 1938.	2 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Tea Cess (Temporary Increase Continuation) Ordinance, No. 36 of 1933, and without prejudice to anything done under or by virtue of that Ordinance— (1) the provisions of section 3 of the Tea Cess (Temporary Increase) Ordinance, 1930, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 1938 ; (2) section 2 of the principal Ordinance shall have effect as though there were substituted for the words and figures “31st day of December, 1933” the words and figures “31st day of December, 1938”.

DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance for making provision for the Public, Railway and Colombo Electricity Supply Services for the financial year 1934-35.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:

Short title. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, No. of 1934.

Appropriation for the financial year 1934-35. 2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding Seventy-six million seven hundred and nineteen thousand six hundred and thirty-four rupees, twenty-one million six hundred thousand rupees, and two million three hundred and twenty-four thousand rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1934, and ending on September 30, 1935, out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the Schedules to this Ordinance.
