**An Ordinance for making provision for the Public,
Railway and Colombo Electricity Supply Services
for the financial year 1934-35.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :

Short title. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, No. of 1934.

Appropriation for the financial year 1934-35. 2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding Seventy-six million seven hundred and nineteen thousand six hundred and thirty-four rupees, twenty-one million six hundred thousand rupees, and two million three hundred and twenty-four thousand rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1934, and ending on September 30, 1935, out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively ; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the Schedules to this Ordinance.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Ceylon Post Office Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1934. Short title.

2 Paragraph (b) of sub-section (2) of section 23 of the Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908, is hereby amended by the substitution of the word "prescribe" for the word "prescribed." Amendment of section 23 (2) (b) of Ordinance No. 11 of 1908.

Objects and Reasons.

By a typist's error, the word "prescribed" was used for the word "prescribe" in the Bill to amend the Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908, which was published in Government Gazette No. 8,016 of the 3rd November, 1933. The error was not detected during the passage of the Bill through the State Council and accordingly appears in the Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, No. 35 of 1933.

2. This Bill is introduced in accordance with an undertaking given to the Secretary of State for the Colonies that steps would be taken to rectify the mistake at the earliest possible opportunity.

An Ordinance to amend the Wells and Pits Protection Ordinance, 1884.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Wells and Pits Protection Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1934.

2 The following section shall be added immediately after section 15 of the Wells and Pits Protection Ordinance, 1884, and shall have effect as section 15A of that Ordinance :—

" 15A. (1) All the powers of a Government Agent or of an Assistant Government Agent under this Ordinance shall, in any area within the administrative limits of any Municipal Council constituted under the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, or any other written law, or of any Urban District Council constituted under the Local Government Ordinance, No. 11 of 1920, and in respect of all property situated therein, be exercised by the Chairman of that Council to the exclusion of the Government Agent or the Assistant Government Agent of the district of which the area forms a part.

(2) In the application of section 12 of this Ordinance to any property situated within the administrative limits of any Municipal Council or Urban District Council, all references in that section to the Crown shall be construed as references to that Council."

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to give to the Chairmen of Municipal Councils and Urban District Councils, within their respective areas, the power to cause wells and pits to be inspected and to take measures for the construction and maintenance of fences round unenclosed wells and pits. This power can at present be exercised only by Government Agents and Assistant Government Agents under the Wells and Pits Protection Ordinance, No. 27 of 1884. The first part of the new section proposed to be inserted in that Ordinance makes necessary provision to give effect to the object of the Bill ; while the second part makes a consequential amendment which assimilates the position of the Councils to that of the Crown under section 12 of the Ordinance with regard to properties within their areas which are seized and sold for the recovery of costs.
