Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 13 of 1934.

**An Ordinance for making provision for the Public,
Railway and Colombo Electricity Supply Services
for the financial year 1934-35.**

R. E. STUBBS.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, No. 13 of 1934.

2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding Seventy-seven million one hundred and seventy-seven thousand four hundred and one rupees, twenty-one million six hundred thousand rupees, and two million three hundred and twenty-four thousand rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1934, and ending on September 30, 1935, out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively ; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the Schedules to this Ordinance.
