DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :-

G 847

An Ordinance to amend the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :-

This Ordinance may be cited as the Village Communities Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1934.

Section 19 of the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924, is hereby amended by the addition of the following further proviso thereto :-

" Provided further-

- (i) that the Governor with the advice of the Executive Committee of Local Administration may in respect of any village committee, by order published in the Gazette, substitute for the aforesaid day the last day of any other month whether in the year referred to in this section or in the year immediately preceding or following that year, but so that the period by which the term of office of the committee is extended or curtailed by the order shall not exceed twelve months ; and (ii) that in the application of this Part of the Ordinance
 - to any committee in respect of which an order is so made, all references to the last day of June and to the first day of July shall be deemed to be references respectively to the date substituted by the order and to the day following that date.'

Objects and Reasons.

The provision in section 19 of the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924, that every village committee is to go out of office in its third year on the last day of June, makes it necessary to complete elections in various parts of each Province during the months of April, May and June each year. The number of these elections is found in many cases to be inconveniently large, and in order to avoid this congestion of work and the resulting confusion, it is proposed by this amendment to give the Governor the power to fix other dates wherever a change is considered desirable.
