Separate tenders, which must be in sealed envelopes superscribed with the name of the right as defined in column 2 of the schedule hereto, will be received at the Colombo Kachcheri until 11 A.M. on Friday, November 23, 1934, when they will be opened. All persons making the tenders will be required to be present, or to satisfy the Government Agent by some duly accredited agent that the tender is made *bona fide*.

3. The purchase amounts shall be paid in full on the day of sale.

4. The purchaser or his workmen shall not cut any tree or interfere with any existing fence or boundary or landmarks or drains, ditches.

5. The purchaser shall be bound to fence the land leased to him, if called on by the Government Agent to do so.

6. The purchaser shall not assign or sublet the property to any other person without the permission previously obtained in writing from the Government Agent.

7. The purchaser shall keep the premises clean and in good order, pay all rates and taxes, and also comply with the regulations of the Local Administrative Body.

8. The purchaser shall not sell or remove gravel, sand, &c., from the demised premises, and he is further warned not to spoil or damage any portion of the said premises.

9. If the whole or any portion of the land is required by Government, such land or portion shall be surrendered *on a week's notice* being given. 10. No milch cows or she-buffaloes shall be permitted to graze on the land, and any such animals found grazing thereon will be liable to seizure by the lessor or any person duly authorized by him.

11. Structures of any sort or the running of tea booths on the land outside the existing buildings without the Government Agent's special sanction are prohibited.

12. In the event of any breach of the foregoing conditions, the Government shall have the power to resume possession of the land or house and eject the purchaser and his workmen without compensation.

13. The Government Agent reserves the right to accept or reject any tender.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent of the Province of Sabaragamuwa will receive sealed tenders for the right to gem for a period of one year in the under-mentioned Crown lands, situated in the Ratnapura District of the Province of Sabaragamuwa.

2. The tenders, which must be enclosed in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tender for the Right to Gem" will be received at the Ratnapura Kachcheri until 11 A.M. on November 30, 1934, when they will be opened, and all persons making tenders will be required to be present or satisfy the Government Agent, Province of Sabaragamuwa, by some duly accredited agent or agents that the tender is *bona fide*.

3. The person whose tender is accepted by the Government Agent will be required to deposit the full amount of his tender at once in cash, and to enter into a lease permit on form G.A.—A 133 for the due fulfilment of the conditions on which the tender is accepted.

4. The amount deposited is liable to forfeiture if the tenderer fails to enter into a lease permit within three months from the date of acceptance of the tender.
