GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

THE RABIES ORDINANCE, 1893.

BY virtue of the powers vested in him by sub-section (2) of section 12A of the Rabies Ordinance, 1893, the Governor hereby notifies that all licences issued in respect of the class of dogs specified in the schedule hereto shall be entitled to the exemption conferred by the proviso to that sub-section.

SCHEDULE.

All dogs proved to the satisfaction of the Principal Collector of Customs to have been imported into the Island for the purpose of exhibition at any Show held or organized by the Ceylon Kennel Club.

FROM and after the 24th day of December, 1934, no person shall remove or transport country rice or paddy from the Demala hatpattu division of Puttalam District in the North-Western Province, except on permits issued by the Assistant Government Agent, Puttalam.
