Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the School Teachers' Pension Amendment Ordinance, No. 13 of 1933.

Deletion of “in assisted schools” and “in an assisted school” in the principal Ordinance.

2 The School Teachers' Pension Ordinance, No. 6 of 1927 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) is amended by deleting the words “in assisted schools” and the words “in an assisted school” wherever the said words occur therein.

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 2 of the principal Ordinance is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:—

“ 2 In this Ordinance unless the context otherwise requires ‘teacher’ means a teacher in a school maintained wholly or partially from the public funds of the Island.”

Amendment of section 5 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 5 of the principal Ordinance is amended by the addition of the following new sub-section (3) at the end:—

“ (3) Nothing in this Ordinance or any rules thereunder shall entitle any person to receive in respect of the same period of service more than one pension out of the public funds of the Island.”

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend the Motor Car Ordinance, 1927.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Motor Car Amendment Ordinance, 1933.

Insertion of new section 63A in the principal Ordinance.

2 The Motor Car Ordinance 1927 is amended by inserting the following new section 63A between section 63 and section 64 thereof:—

Right to weigh over-loaded hiring cars and lorries.

63A When a police officer not below the rank of Sergeant has reasonable ground to suspect that a hiring car or lorry carries a load in excess of the maximum load allowed therefor, he may require the person who is in charge of the vehicle at the time, to allow it to be weighed either laden or unladen, and for that purpose to drive it or to allow it to be driven to the nearest weighbridge or other machine for weighing vehicles; and if the person so required refuses

or neglects to comply with any such requirement he shall be guilty of an offence. Provided that by virtue of this section (a) no person shall be required to drive a hiring car or lorry or to allow it to be driven for a greater distance than one mile except where the whole of the distance is within the administrative limits either of a Municipal Council or of an Urban District Council and (b) no hiring car or lorry shall be detained for a longer period than three hours.

Objects and Reasons.

Under the Motor Car Ordinance 1927, it is possible to fix the maximum loads that may be carried in hiring cars and lorries. The Ordinance does not, however, enable a police officer to place before the court the best evidence of a transgression of these limits, because it does not empower him to get such a vehicle weighed at the time when he suspects it to be violating the law in this respect.

This Bill provides the authority without which the existing restrictions on loads are largely nugatory.

THIS matter coming on for disposal before C. E. de Pinto, Esq., District Judge of Kegalla, on June 19, 1933, in the presence of Mr. A. A. Wickramasinghe, Proctor, on the part of the petitioner; and his affidavit and petition dated June 15 and 19, 1933, respectively, having been read:

It is ordered that the petitioner be and he is hereby declared entitled, as son of the above-named deceased, to have letters of administration to his estate issued to him, unless the respondents or any person or persons interested shall, on or before August 2, 1933, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of the court to the contrary.
