This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, No. 20 of 1933.

Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding seventy-three million five hundred and twenty-eight thousand nine hundred and thirtythree rupees, twenty million rupees, and two million two hundred and eighty four thousand nine hundred and fifty rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1933, and ending on September 30, 1934, out of the revenue and other funds of the Island, the Ceylon Government Railway, and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the Schedules to this Ordinance.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :----

An Ordinance to amend The Jaffna Markets Ordinance, 1891.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :---

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Jaffna Markets Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1933.

2 The following new section. 20 is added at the end of The Jaffna Markets Ordinance, 1891 :---

"20 (1) In all areas in the Northern Province which have been brought under the operation of 'The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924,' the following consequences shall ensue in respect of the public markets situated or held therein :

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall subject to the other provisions of this section cease to apply to such public markets.
- (b) Every such public market and the land on which it is held shall from a date to be fixed by the Executive Committee of Local Administration be deemed to be vested in and under the control of the inhabitants of the sub-division in which such public market is situated.
- (c) The District Committee in which any such public markets are situated shall transfer the 'Market Fund' to the inhabitants of the sub-division in which such markets are situated, in such proportions as the Executive Committee of Local Administration shall determine.
- (d) The transfer of such public markets under this section shall not affect the validity either (i) of any by-laws under section 6 concerning them which shall continue in force until rescinded, varied or amended by rules made under 'The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924,' or (ii) of any lease affecting them granted under section 14.

.(2) In all areas in the Northern Province which have been brought under the operation of 'The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924,' the following consequences shall ensue with reference to the private markets situated or held therein :

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance concerning private markets shall apply as if the inhabitants of the sub-divisions in which such private markets are situated were vested with all the powers of a District Committee.
- (b) The annual fees recovered for licences by virtue of by-laws made under section 6 shall for all purposes be deemed to be fees recovered by virtue of rules made under section 29 (4) of 'The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.'

(3) The power of making by-laws conferred on the inhabitants of a sub-division by this section may be delegated by them to any Village Committee that they may elect under section 14 of 'The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.'"

Objects and Reasons.

All markets in the Northern Province were originally vested in the local District Committees and controlled solely under the Jaffna Markets Ordinance, 1891.

2. By amending Ordinances of 1908 (No. 6) and 1910 (No. 16) such of these markets as were situated within the limits of Local Boards and Sanitary Boards were transferred to the control of such Local Boards and Sanitary Boards respectively.

3. This Bill transfers the public markets not affected by previous amendments to the inhabitants of the sub-division in which they are situated, and provides that their future control shall be in accordance with The Village Communities Odrinance, No. 9 of 1924.

Short title.

Addition of new section 20 to the principal Ordinance. Transfer of

markets to inhabitants of sub-divisions. 4. With regard to private markets in the Northern Province, this Bill provides that the inhabitants of the subdivisions in which they are situated shall exercise the powers now enjoyed by the District Road Committees in respect of them.

5. Provision is also made in this Bill for the delegation by the inhabitants to Village Committees of the powers that they derive by virtue of the present amendment, so that the control over such markets may be approximated to the practice concerning markets governed by The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1933.

Amendment of section 115 of the principal Ordinance. 2 Section 115 (1) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, is amended by inserting the words "provided that all houses, buildings, lands or tenements which are situated within an area not benefited by the conservancy service provided by the Council shall be exempt from any portion of such rate or rates that is declared by a resolution of the Council to be levied for the purpose of providing such service;" between the word "rates" at the end of line 16 and the word "and" at the beginning of line 17.

Objects and Reasons.

Though the amount that a Municipal Council imposes as rates under section 115 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, is largely dependent on the nature and variety of the public utility services that it undertakes, the extent to which any particular area within its boundaries is actually benefited by such services cannot at present be taken into account in recovering such rates. This Bill is designed therefore to enable a Council to exempt from the portion of its rates that it has imposed specially to meet the cost of its conservancy service, those parts of a Municipal town's area as are not benefited by the service that it provides for this purpose.

Provided however that the necessary apparel of the offender and his family, and to the value of twenty-five rupees the tools and implements of his trade including therein seed corn, shall not be taken under such warrants of distress." 3 Section 95 (1) (iii) of the principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion of the words "the levy of the amount of fines by distress and sale of movable property" between the word "judgments" and the word "the" in line 1.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

1. Section 57 (1) of The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924, permits a Village Tribunal or Committee to impose a fine in the exercise of its criminal jurisdiction, and in default of payment of the fine to impose a sentence of imprisonment. As there is at present no power in the Ordinance to levy the amount of the fine by distress and sale of property, clause 2 adds a new sub-section to section 57 which provides the authority requisite for this purpose in terms similar to those of section 312 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1898. To provide the details necessary for the carrying out of the new right, clause 3 expands the rule making powers that exist in section 95.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :-

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Tea (Control of Export) Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1933.

2 Between section 26 and section 27 of the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") the following new section 26A is inserted :—

"26A. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 26 the proprietor of a small holding shall not be entitled to receive from the Controller in respect of any period tea coupons representing the entire amount recognized therein, if the Controller decides after such inquiry as he may consider necessary that by reason of the failure of such proprietor to maintain it in proper condition such small holding is not likely to produce such amount during such period.

(2) For the purpose of giving effect to a decision under sub-section (1) the Controller may reduce the amount of or refuse any tea coupons that such proprietor would ordinarily have been entitled to receive under the provisions of section 26.

(3) An appeal shall lie to the Board of Appeal against any decision of the Controller under sub-section (1) ".

3 Section 34 of the principal Ordinance is amended as follows:----

- (a) In sub-section (1) the words "period of twelve months commencing on the appointed day" are substituted for the words "year then current" in the last line.
- (b) In sub-section (2) the words "fifteenth day of January" are substituted for the words "first day of November" in line 2 and the words "period of assessment" are substituted for the word "year" wherever it occurs therein.

4 Section 35 (5) of the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting the words "as soon after its publication under sub-section (4) as practicable" for the words "at the first meeting of the Council held after the date of the publication of that rule under sub-section (4)" in lines 2, 3, and 4.

5 Between section 41 and section 42 of the principal Ordinance the following new section 41 A is inserted :---

"41A. The Executive Committee may give directions in any particular case or generally, and may make rules in respect of any matter necessary for the administration of this Ordinance which is not specially provided for therein, and such directions and rules on being published in the Gazette shall have force of law."

Objects and Reasons.

1. Clause 2 permits the Controller to alter the amount of tea in respect of which a small holder is entitled to have coupons, if the Controller is satisfied that the land is owing to neglect rendered incapable of producing such full amount of tea.

2. Clause 3 fixes with reference to the date appointed under section 22 the year in respect of which estimates of income and expenditure have to be prepared and forwarded by the Controller. It also provides that the estimates should be submitted to the Minister on the 15th day of January in each period of assessment.

3. Section 35 of the principal Ordinance requires rules published in the Gazette thereunder to be brought before the State Council at the first meeting of the Council after publication. Clause 4 permits such rules to be brought up "as soon after publication as practicable."

4. Clause 5 empowers the Executive Committee to give directions in respect of any matter or thing unprovided for in the Ordinance.


