GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

ORDINANCE No. 11 OF 1933.

0927/1 (S.B.)

IT is hereby notified that the following Resolution under section 32 (1) and (3) of Ordinance No. 11 of 1933 passed by the State Council at its session on September 15, 1933, has been duly submitted to and sanctioned by His Excellency the Governor, and that it will take effect from midnight of September 30/October 1, 1933 :—

“ That this Council do resolve, under the provisions of section 32 (1) and (3) of Ordinance No. 11 of 1933, that from and after the date on which the sanction of the Governor to this resolution shall be notified in the *Government Gazette*, there shall be charged, levied, and paid, in addition to the export duty imposed under Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, the Medical Wants Ordinance, No. 9 of 1912, the Tea Research Ordinance, 1925, the Tea Cess (Temporary) Increase Ordinance, 1930, the Tea Propaganda Ordinance, 1932, and section 32 (1) of the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, 1933, an export duty of ten cents per hundred pounds of tea exported from this Island, for the purpose of providing further income for the payment of the expenses of the administration of the Ordinance and such other expenses as may be authorized under section 33 thereof ”.
