## DRAFT ORDINANCES.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

**An Ordinance to amend The Jaffna Markets Ordinance, 1891.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Jaffna Markets Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1933.

Addition of new section 20 to the principal Ordinance.

2 The following new section 20 is added at the end of The Jaffna Markets Ordinance, 1891:—

Transfer of markets to inhabitants of sub-divisions.

“20 (1) In all areas in the Northern Province which have been brought under the operation of ‘The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924,’ the following consequences shall ensue in respect of the public markets situated or held therein:

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall subject to the other provisions of this section cease to apply to such public markets.
- (b) Every such public market and the land on which it is held shall from a date to be fixed by the Executive Committee of Local Administration be deemed to be vested in and under the control of the inhabitants of the sub-division in which such public market is situated.
- (c) The District Committee in which any such public markets are situated shall transfer the ‘Market Fund’ to the inhabitants of the sub-division in which such markets are situated, in such proportions as the Executive Committee of Local Administration shall determine.
- (d) The transfer of such public markets under this section shall not affect the validity either (i) of any by-laws under section 6 concerning them which shall continue in force until rescinded, varied or amended by rules made under ‘The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924,’ or (ii) of any lease affecting them granted under section 14.

(2) In all areas in the Northern Province which have been brought under the operation of ‘The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924,’ the following consequences shall ensue with reference to the private markets situated or held therein:

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance concerning private markets shall apply as if the inhabitants of the sub-divisions in which such private markets are situated were vested with all the powers of a District Committee.
- (b) The annual fees recovered for licences by virtue of by-laws made under section 6 shall for all purposes be deemed to be fees recovered by virtue of rules made under section 29 (4) of ‘The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.’

(3) The power of making by-laws conferred on the inhabitants of a sub-division by this section may be delegated by them to any Village Committee that they may elect under section 14 of ‘The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.’”

*Objects and Reasons.*

All markets in the Northern Province were originally vested in the local District Committees and controlled solely under the Jaffna Markets Ordinance, 1891.

2. By amending Ordinances of 1908 (No. 6) and 1910 (No. 16) such of these markets as were situated within the limits of Local Boards and Sanitary Boards were transferred to the control of such Local Boards and Sanitary Boards respectively.

3. This Bill transfers the public markets not affected by previous amendments to the inhabitants of the sub-division in which they are situated, and provides that their future control shall be in accordance with The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.

4. With regard to private markets in the Northern Province, this Bill provides that the inhabitants of the subdivisions in which they are situated shall exercise the powers now enjoyed by the District Road Committees in respect of them.

5. Provision is also made in this Bill for the delegation by the inhabitants to Village Committees of the powers that they derive by virtue of the present amendment, so that the control over such markets may be approximated to the practice concerning markets governed by The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

AL 55/33

**An Ordinance to amend the Land Settlement Ordinance, 1931.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Land Settlement Ordinance, No. of 1933.

Short title.

2 Section 11 of the Land Settlement Ordinance, 1931, is amended by the deletion of sub-section (1) (a) and the substitution of the following therefor :—

Amendment of section 11 of the principal Ordinance.

“(a) The Deputy Chief Secretary or an officer selected from Class I of the Ceylon Civil Service ; and ”

*Objects and Reasons.*

The purpose of this amendment is to permit of the appointment of the Deputy Chief Secretary as a member of the Board constituted under section 11 of the Land Settlement Ordinance, 1931, to decide applications under section 6 (4) of that Ordinance.

It is desirable that the Deputy Chief Secretary should be a member of the Board but as he is a staff officer who is not graded in any class of the Civil Service, the present wording of the section does not authorise his appointment.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1933.

Short title.

2 Section 115 (1) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, is amended by inserting the words “ provided that all houses, buildings, lands or tenements which are situated within an area not benefited by the conservancy service provided by the Council shall be exempt from any portion of such rate or rates that is declared by a resolution of the Council to be levied for the purpose of providing such service;” between the word “ rates ” at the end of line 16 and the word “ and ” at the beginning of line 17.

Amendment of section 115 of the principal Ordinance.

*Objects and Reasons.*

Though the amount that a Municipal Council imposes as rates under section 115 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, is largely dependent on the nature and variety of the public utility services that it undertakes, the extent to which any particular area within its boundaries is actually benefited by such services cannot at present be taken into account in recovering such rates. This Bill is designed therefore to enable a Council to exempt from the portion of its rates that it has imposed specially to meet the cost of its conservancy service, those parts of a Municipal town's area as are not benefited by the service that it provides for this purpose.

**An Ordinance to amend The Informers' Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Informers' Reward (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1933.

Amendment of section 2A of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 2A of the Informers' Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914, is amended by the insertion of the words "or the Assistant Government Agent" between the word "Agent" and the word "shall" in line 3.

*Objects and Reasons.*

Section 2A of The Informers' Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914, permits the payment into a general fund for the reward of headmen of all awards made under the Ordinance to individual headmen, provided that they have been appointed in writing by the Government Agent. As headmen under the Irrigation Ordinance, No. 45 of 1917, may be appointed either by a Government Agent or an Assistant Government Agent this Bill amends section 2A so as to bring under the operation of the Ordinance headmen appointed by Assistant Government Agents as well.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

**An Ordinance to amend The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Village Communities (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1933.

Amendment of section 57 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 57 of the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is amended by the addition of the following new sub-section (6) at the end—

"(6) Whenever an offender is sentenced to pay a fine the President of the Village Tribunal or the Chairman of the Village Committee passing the sentence may issue a warrant for the levy of the amount by distress and sale of any movable property belonging to the offender, although the sentence directs that in default of payment of the fine the offender shall be imprisoned. Provided however that the necessary apparel of the offender and his family, and to the value of twenty-five rupees the tools and implements of his trade including therein seed corn, shall not be taken under such warrants of distress."

3 Section 95 (1) (iii) of the principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion of the words "the levy of the amount of fines by distress and sale of movable property" between the word "judgments" and the word "the" in line 1.

Amendment of section 95 of the principal Ordinance.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

1. Section 57 (1) of The Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924, permits a Village Tribunal or Committee to impose a fine in the exercise of its criminal jurisdiction, and in default of payment of the fine to impose a sentence of imprisonment. As there is at present no power in the Ordinance to levy the amount of the fine by distress and sale of property, clause 2 adds a new sub-section to section 57 which provides the authority requisite for this purpose in terms similar to those of section 312 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1898. To provide the details necessary for the carrying out of the new right, clause 3 expands the rule making powers that exist in section 95.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1933.

Short title.

2 Part I of Schedule B of the Stamp Ordinance, 1909, is amended by the insertion of the following new item 51E between item 51D and item 52 :—

Amendment of Part I of Schedule B of the principal Ordinance.

51E Transfer or assignment of any stock or marketable security—the duty shall be charged ad valorem, according to the following scale except in the cases provided in items 22 (c), 22 (d), and 22 (d 2) :

*Objects and Reasons.*

When shares in a company are transferred the stamp duty on the transaction is at present calculated under item 22 (b) in Part I of Schedule B of the Stamp Ordinance, 1909, on the actual consideration for the transfer. The purpose of this amendment is to make such transfers liable to an *ad valorem* duty which is calculated on the average price of the share or its market value on the day of the transfer.
