THE MUNICIPAL COUNCILS ORDINANCE, 1910.

B 1185

RULE made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 21 (3) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, and by Article 93 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931.

RULE.

The rules set out in Schedule B to the Ordinance are hereby varied and supplemented as follows:—

(1) by the deletion of rule 1 and the substitution of the following rule therefor:—

“1. The Chairman shall provide a polling place for each division, and shall appoint a person, in these rules called ‘the presiding officer,’ to preside at each polling place. The Chairman may at his discretion nominate a substitute to act for the presiding officer in the event of that officer’s absence from the polling place, and may also appoint one or more persons to assist the presiding officer in the performance of his duties.”;

(2) by the deletion of rules 3 and 4 and the substitution of the following rules therefor:—

“3. The writing or nomination must be subscribed by two voters of the division for which the candidate seeks to be elected as proposer and seconder respectively, and by not less than eight nor more than twelve other such voters as assenting to the nomination.

“4. Each candidate must be nominated by a separate nomination paper.”

(3) by the deletion of rules 6 and 7 and the substitution of the following therefor:—

“6. The nomination paper shall be in the Form I at the end of these rules, and shall contain the particulars therein set out. The Chairman or Secretary of the Council must supply nomination papers to any person whose name appears in the list of persons qualified to be elected as Councillors, and no nomination paper shall be used for any election, except a paper so supplied by the Chairman or Secretary for that purpose. No nomination paper shall consist of portions of a form or forms pasted together.

“7. (1) Every nomination paper subscribed as aforesaid must be delivered by the candidate or his proposer or seconder at the Municipal Office by or before 11 o’clock in the forenoon, in the case of the triennial general election on November 7 (or if that is a Sunday or public holiday, then on the first day after that date on which the office is open), and in the case of any other election, on such date as the Chairman may appoint, after fourteen days’ notice in the *Government Gazette* and in two or more of the local newspapers.

“(2) The Chairman shall decide on the validity of every nomination paper, and his decision shall be final.”

(4) by the relettering of paragraphs (f), (g), and (h) of rule 11 as paragraphs (g), (h), and (i), respectively, of that rule and by the insertion of the following new paragraph (f) :—

“(f) If, as the result of any decision under section 22 of the Ordinance, it should appear that a person has by falsely personating a qualified voter recorded a vote, the person entitled to vote shall be permitted to exercise his right, and the Chairman shall declare the vote recorded by the false personation void, and on the opening of the ballot box shall on tracing the ballot paper accepted by reason of the false personation have the same removed, so that it shall not be counted among the votes recorded.”;

(5) by the addition of the following new rules 12 and 13 and the Form I immediately after rule 11 :—

“12. Each candidate may, by writing signed by him, or if he is absent from the Island, then his proposer or seconder may, by writing signed by him, appoint a person (in this schedule referred to as the candidate's representative) to attend the proceedings for nomination before the Chairman on behalf of the candidate, and this appointment must be delivered to the Secretary before 11 o'clock in the forenoon of the day fixed for delivery of nomination papers.”

“13. Each candidate and his representative may, during the time appointed by the Chairman for the inspection of the nomination papers, object to the nomination paper of any other candidate for the same division.”

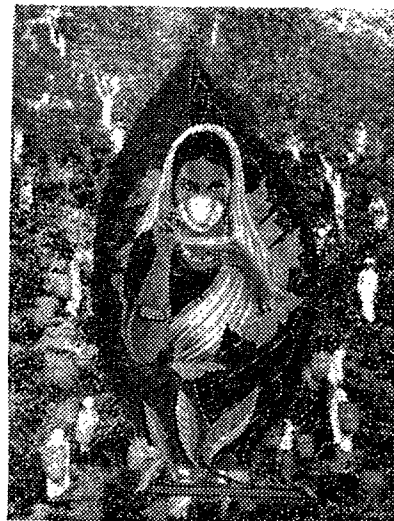
