WHEREAS HIS EXCELLENCY SIR REGINALD EDWARD STUBBS, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies, has this day quitted the Island :

It is hereby proclaimed that in conformity with His Majesty's Will and Pleasure declared in the Letters Patent dated the Twenty-second day of April in the twenty-first year of His reign, constituting the Office of Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies, the Honourable Sir FRANCIS GRAEME TYRRELL, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, the officer lawfully discharging the functions of Chief Secretary to the Government at the time of the departure of the said Governor, has this day assumed administration of the Government of the Island :

Whereof all persons are hereby required to take due notice.

Given at Colombo, this Twelfth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-five.
