MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:

M. L. A.-B 1217

No. 6 of 1910.

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:-

Short title.

This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1935.

Amendment of section 130 (3) of Ordinance No. 6 of 1910.

2 Sub-section (3) of section 130 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "made over or" of the words "made over".

Repeal of section 134 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 134 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Objects and Reasons.

By section 127 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, a Municipal Council is empowered, with the sanction of the Governor, to levy an annual tax on the vehicles and animals specified in Schedule D to that Ordinance. Section 132 provides that the tax shall be paid before the 31st day of March in each year, and section 134 requires the Chairman or an officer authorized by him to send to every person supposed to be liable to the payment of the tax a Schedule which must be filled up and returned to the Municipal Office.

- 2. It has been found that the Schedules required by section 134 serve no useful purpose and that they are no longer necessary. Since 1928, number-plates have been affixed to vehicles as an indication of the fact that the tax leviable on such vehicles has been paid. Horse stables, cattle sheds, and galas are subject to the supervision and control of the Council and, by section 135 the Chairman or any person appointed by him for the purpose is authorized to enter and inspect any place in which he has reason to believe that there is any vehicle or animal liable to taxation under the Ordinance. These provisions have been found sufficient to secure the due payment of the tax, independently of the Schodules issued under section 124. Clarge 2 of the of the Schedules issued under section 134. Clause 3 of the Bill accordingly repeals section 134 and dispenses with the necessity for the annual issue of Schedules to persons entitled to the custody, possession or control of vehicles or animals.
- 3. The opportunity has been taken in Clause 2 of the Bill to rectify a printer's error occurring in section 2 of the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, No. 8 of 1935, which amended section 130 of the principal Ordinance.

The Rules made under The Council of Legal Education Incorporation Ordinance, 1900, as last amended by Notification dated November 28, 1934, published in Gazette No. 8,094 of December 7, 1934, were further amended at a meeting of the Council held on June 27, 1935, as Rules. follows:

1. Rule 6 is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:

6 (1) All moneys payable to the Council shall be deposited to the credit of the Council in an account countied the "Income Account" in such bank as the Council shall from time to time by resolution appoint.

(2) No moneys shall be drawn from the Income Account except in pursuance of a resolution passed at a meeting of the Council and except on cheques signed both by the Chairman of such meeting and by the Registrar.

2. Rule 23 is amended by the substitution of the words "pay to the Council" for the words "pay to the Treasurer on behalf of the Council".

3. Rules 33, 39, 45, 52, 53, 56, and 59 are amended by substituting the words "to the Council" for the words "to the Treasurer".

4. Rule 54 is amended by substituting the words "on payment to the Council" for the words "on payment to the Treasurer

5. Rules 49, 55, and 60 are amended by substituting the words "Registrar of the Supreme Court" for the word "Registrar".

6. Rules 58 and 71 are amended by substituting the words "to the Council" for the words "to the Secretary".

7. Rule 77 is amended by adding at the end the words "There shall be an additional vacation in each year to be called the August vacation which shall begin and end on the days appointed for the commencement and termination respectively of the August vacation of the Supreme Court".

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
