THE PUBLIC REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE, No. 33 OF 1921.

THE following Order, made by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon under section 2 of "The Public Revenue Protection Ordinance, No. 33 of 1921," is hereby published for general information.

THE PUBLIC REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE, No. 33 OF 1921.

Order under Section 2.

WHEREAS I, Francis Graeme Tyrrell, the Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, have, during the present session of the State Council, approved of the introduction into that Council of a resolution whereby the import duties now payable on the goods, wares, or merchandise specified in Column 1 of the schedule hereto shall be altered :

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Public Revenue Protection Ordinance, No. 33 of 1921, and by Article 93 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, I do hereby order the Principal Collector of Customs from midnight of October 16/17, 1935, to demand and to levy on the goods, wares, or merchandise specified in Column 1 of the schedule hereto the respective import duties set out in Column 2 or in Column 3 as the case may be, in lieu of the import duties payable thereon under the existing law.
